**ORDINANCE NO. 811 Series of 2020**  
**AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE USE OF ELECTRIC SCOOTERS OR E-SCOOTERS IN THE CITY OF VALENZUELA AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.**

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** This ordinance shall be known as the "2020 E-Scooter Ordinance of Valenzuela City".  
**SECTION 2. SCOPE.** This ordinance shall be applicable to all electric scooters operating or traversing within Valenzuela City.  
**SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.**  
**Electric Scooter or E-Scooter** – A stand-up vehicle powered by electric motor which is designed to travel on two or three wheels. Classified as a micromobility, this scooter is generally designed with handlebars and a large deck in the center on which the rider stands.  
**SECTION 4. USE OF PROTECTIVE GEARS.** No person shall be allowed to ride an e-scooter without wearing helmet. Wearing of knee pads, wrist pads, elbow pads is highly encouraged.  
**SECTION 5. AGE LIMIT.** E-scooter drivers traversing and operating in all roads, streets, alleys, must at least be 17 years of age. However, individuals less than 17 years old may drive or use the same within their respective private property or compound under the supervision of their parents and guardians.  
**SECTION 6. BAN ON MAC ARTHUR HIGHWAY.** All e-scooters are allowed to traverse in all roads, streets, alleys within the jurisdiction of Valenzuela City. However, all e-scooters shall not be permitted to traverse along Mac Arthur Highway.

**ALLOWABLE AREAS / ALTERNATE ROUTES FOR E-SCOOTERS TO CROSS ALONG MCARTHUR HIGHWAY**



**SECTION 7. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY** – Any violation of this ordinance shall be meted with an administrative penalty to pay Five Hundred Pesos (Php 500.00) or render twenty four (24) hours community service.  
**SECTION 8. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS** – While this Ordinance and the provisions hereof are already operative upon its effectivity, the City Mayor may promulgate relevant rules and regulations necessary for the effective implementation of this Ordinance. Any subsequent rules and regulations issued by national agencies or department relevant to the foregoing ordinance shall form an integral part of this ordinance.  
**SECTION 9. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** If for any reason, a part of this Ordinance is declared illegal or invalid, other parts or provisions hereof which are not affected thereby shall remain valid and in full force and effect.  
**SECTION 10. REPEALING CLAUSE.** All previous Ordinance and rules/regulations which are inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance hereby deemed, modified or repealed accordingly.  
**SECTION 11. EFFECTIVITY CLAUSE.** This ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval. Approved on the 14<sup>th</sup> Special Session of the Sangguniang Panlungsod of Valenzuela, November 03, 2020.

**ORDINANCE NO. 812 Series of 2020**  
**AN ORDINANCE SETTING THE MANDATORY SAFETY MEASURES AS STANDARD FOR GENERAL COMMUNITY QUARANTINE (GCQ) FOR THE WORKPLACE IN SPAS IN THE CITY OF VALENZUELA, IMPOSING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES**

**SECTION 1. TITLE.** – This Ordinance shall be known as "GCQ Protocols for Spa Ordinance".  
**SECTION 2. COVERAGE.** – This Ordinance shall cover all Spa or commercial establishment providing facility devoted to improve health, fitness, beauty and relaxation within the jurisdiction of City of Valenzuela.  
**SECTION 3. DUTIES OF BUSINESS OWNER OR EMPLOYERS.** – Business owners and/or the employers of spa shall:  
 1. Provide their employee protective equipment such as, but not limited to, face masks, face shield, gloves, and other similar paraphernalia to prevent and contain the spread of any communicable disease particularly COVID-19;  
 2. Provide a washing area with soap, sanitizer, and/or disinfectant;  
 3. Designate a safety officer to monitor COVID-19 prevention and control measures such as physical distancing, wearing of masks, regular disinfection, compliance to thermal scanning, accomplishing health symptoms questionnaire, and scanning of Valtrace QR Code;  
 4. Put up a COVID-19 Hotline and Call Center for employees to report if symptomatic, and daily monitoring scheme of "suspect" employee condition;  
 5. Implement protocols and policies on sick employees and clients with flu-like symptoms and have fungal infection;  
 6. Implement the Valtrace Ordinance of the City before entering the premise;  
 7. Business owners and/or owners are encouraged to put up a UV Light Box (Ultraviolet) for sanitizing the used tools;  
 8. Post information at the entrance and other prominent or conspicuous areas about the mandatory wearing of face masks, maintaining social distancing, and other helpful information and protocols imposed within the premise;  
 9. Whenever feasible, provide shuttle services and/or decent accommodation on near-site location to lessen employee's travel and movement;  
 10. Adequate ventilation (use of exhaust systems, air purifiers or keeping windows partially open); and  
 11. Submit the New Normal Workforce and Workplace Management Plan.  
**SECTION 4. NEW NORMAL WORKFORCE AND WORKPLACE MANAGEMENT PLAN** – Business owners, managers, operators and/or the employers of Spa shall submit to the City Business Inspection and Audit Team (CBAT) a New

Normal Workforce and Workplace Management Plan (hereafter, the "New Normal Management Plan"). Copy of the New Normal Management Plan template is herein attached as Annex "A" and is made an integral part hereof.  
**SECTION 5. PERIOD TO COMPLY.** – Business owners, managers, operators and/or the employers of Spas shall submit their New Normal Management Plan to the CBAT within five (5) calendar days from the effectivity of this Ordinance or resumption of business operations, whichever is later.  
**SECTION 6. DUTIES OF EMPLOYEES.** – Employees of Spas, upon the resumption of operation, where person-to-person contact is unavoidable, shall strictly comply with the following:  
 1. Observance of proper personal hygiene such as frequent hand washing and sanitizing of tools before and every after use (a 10-minute interval for sanitation in between clients);  
 2. All work areas and frequently handled objects such as door knobs and handles shall be cleaned and disinfected regularly, at least every two (2) hours;  
 3. Washrooms and toilets shall have sufficient clean water and soap;  
 4. Wearing of personal protective equipment such as, but not limited to, face mask, face shield, eye glasses, gloves and hair caps;  
 5. Wearing of closed shoes;  
 6. Observance of the proper disposal of single-use supplies (cotton balls, tissues, etc.). Clothes, linen towels must be laundered (or disposed properly if not washable) after each use;  
 7. Avoid congregating and gathering in a single area especially during breaks and / or lunchtime;  
 8. No talking and no eating in confined areas; and  
 9. Apply best cleaning and disinfection practices in the facility repeatedly.

**SECTION 7. MINIMUM PUBLIC HEALTH STANDARDS AND PROTOCOLS.** – The business establishment shall adopt and implement the following minimum public health standards and protocols to further protect both the employees and clients entering the premises:  
 1. No person shall be allowed to enter the premise without wearing face masks and remove the same only when eating or drinking. "Wear Your Face Mask Ordinance" and the "Valtrace Ordinance" of the City shall be properly observed. Clients/customers are likewise required to observed this policy;  
 2. A temperature check (Thermal scanner) shall be in placed at the entrance of the enclosed establishment;  
 3. All equipments and/or supplies entering the premises must be properly disinfected. The clients are encouraged to bring their own personal tools or vanity kits;  
 4. There shall be available alcohol or sanitizer that can be used by clients for free;  
 5. There shall be roving officer or employee that will ensure and maintain physical distancing of at least one meter apart from each client should there be queuing inside or outside the premise;  
 6. Chairs inside the premise shall be set at least 1-meter apart on all sides to maintain social distancing;  
 7. Put up a well maintained waiting area with proper floor markings to guide clients;  
 8. There shall be a foot bath or floor mat with disinfectant that will sanitize the feet of all entering clients in the spa;  
 9. Maintain social distancing by limiting the number of client inside the full body massage premise to thirty percent (30%) of its normal capacity including employees;  
 10. A health checklist to be distributed to the client;  
 11. A log book to record all persons entering the premise;  
 12. If feasible, set up a do-it-yourself protective barrier or any transparent division in the reception areas and/or between clients to prevent direct contact of individuals;  
 13. Provide cash trays, box, or any container to be used in collecting payments from the client;  
 14. Encourages reservations and/or appointments of clients to avoid overcrowding in the premise. Home services are also encouraged to avoid crowd exposure;  
 15. No bringing of companions, unless absolutely necessary; and  
 16. Increase physical and mental resilience wherein the employees are encourage eating nutritious and well cooked food and drinking plenty of fluids, as well as avoiding alcoholic beverages.

**SECTION 8. DECONTAMINATION OF WORKPLACE.** – should there be any reported positive COVID-19 case in either employees or client, the business establishment shall:  
 1. Decontaminate the workplace with appropriate disinfectant (e.g. chlorine bleaching solution and 1:100 phenol based disinfectant);  
 2. After decontamination of the workplace, the Spa involve may resume its business after 24 hours from the decontamination; and  
 3. Workers present in the work area with the suspect COVID-19 worker shall undergo fourteen (14) days home quarantine with specific instructions by monitoring symptoms and possible next step;  
 4. In the event that an employee is sick or has fever but is not suspected to have COVID-19 (e.g. urinary infection, wound infection and others not related to lungs or respiratory disorder) the employer must advise the employee to take prudent measures to limit the spread of communicable disease as follows;  
 a. Stay at home and keep away from crowded area  
 b. Take adequate rest and take plenty of fluids;  
 c. Practice personal hygiene to prevent spread of disease; and  
 d. Seek appropriate medical care if there is persistent fever, breathing difficulty or has started to become weak.

**SECTION 9. OPERATING HOURS.** – The business establishment shall limit the time of its operation to observe with the curfew hours imposed by the existing law and ordinance.  
**SECTION 10. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY, RULES AND REGULATION.** – The Business Permit and Licensing Office (BPLO) together with City Business Audit Team (CBAT) shall implement the provisions of this Ordinance. The City Mayor may issue implementing rules and regulation if necessary for its effective implementation.  
**SECTION 11. OVERSIGHT COMMITTEE.** – For effective implementation of this Ordinance, an Oversight Committee is hereby created which shall be responsible for the supervision and monitoring of compliance in health-related facilities provided in this Ordinance, and shall be composed of the following:  
 a. Council representative from Committee on Tourism;  
 b. Representative from City Health Office;  
 c. Representative from Office of the Building Official; and  
 d. Representative from the Business Permit and Licensing Office.

**SECTION 12. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTY.** – Any violation of this ordinance shall be meted with the following administrative penalties:

Nature of Offense	Administrative Penalty
A. Individual	One Thousand Pesos (Php. 1,000.00) or Twenty-four (24) hours of community service
B. Juridical Person or Entity	
1 <sup>st</sup> Offensive	Five Thousand Pesos (Php. 5,000.00) and suspension of business operations until rectification of the violation.
2 <sup>nd</sup> Offense	Ten Thousand Pesos (Php. 10,000.00) and suspension of business operations until rectification of the violation and twenty-four (24) hours community service to be completed by the business owners, employers or officers of the violating entity
3 <sup>rd</sup> Offense	Fifteen Thousand Pesos (15,000.00) and Revocation of Business Permit

**SECTION 13. PENAL PROVISIONS.** – Any violation of this ordinance shall be punishable by imprisonment of two (2) months or a fine of not less than ONE THOUSAND PESOS (Php. 1,000.00) but not more than FIVE THOUSAND PESOS (Php. 5,000.00), or both, such imprisonment and fine at the discretion of the court.  
**SECTION 14. INCORPORATION CLAUSE** – Any subsequent relevant issuance of the Inter-Agency Task Force on Emerging and Infectious Diseases, Department of Trade and Industry, Department of Health or any national agency shall be deemed incorporated in this Ordinance.  
**SECTION 15. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.** – If for any reason, any part or provision of this Ordinance is declared unconstitutional or invalid by a competent court, the remaining sections or provisions not affected thereby shall continue to be in full force and effect.  
**SECTION 16. REPEALING CLAUSE.** – All ordinances, resolutions, rules or regulations inconsistent with or contrary to the provisions of this Ordinance are hereby repealed, amended, or modified accordingly.  
**SECTION 17. EFFECTIVITY.** – This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval due to the urgency of the concern caused by the COVID-19 pandemic. Should the declared state of emergency be lifted, the regulations imposed in this Ordinance shall accordingly be automatically repealed without need of further action from Sangguniang Panlungsod.
