**ORDER**

This is a verified petition for Correction of Entry and Change of Surname in the Certificate of Live Birth of Nathaniel Lagman Serrana to Nathaniel Lagman under Registry No. 2012-6571 filed by petitioner, thru counsel filed of February 11, 2020.

Petitioner NATHANIEL LAGMAN SERRANA (Nathaniel for brevity) is a minor, 8 years of age, a Filipino Citizen, and is represented by his biological mother, LEAH L. LAGMAN (Leah for brevity), of legal age, Filipino, and is currently single, both of them are residents of Block 19, Lot 7 Dovetail St., Phase 5, Dizon Estate, Brgy. San Agustin, San Fernando City, Pampanga; private respondent, EDWIN MANGALONSO SERRANA, is the name appearing as father of the minor NATHANIEL LAGMAN SERRANA; public respondent, LOCAL CIVIL REGISTRAR OF MALOLOS CITY, with address at Malolos City Hall, Jacinto St., San Vicente, Malolos and the CIVIL REGISTRAR GENERAL, PHILIPPINE STATISTICS AUTHORITY, with address at East Avenue, Diliman, Quezon City are the government agencies empowered to record births, marriages, and deaths; Public respondent REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, represented by Office of the Solicitor General is empowered to represent the State with office address at 134 Amorsolo St., Legaspi Vill., Makati City; Nathaniel was born in the City of Malolos, Bulacan on 19 November 2011 and registered in the Local Civil Registry of Malolos, Bulacan; Nathaniel was born to parents Leah L. Lagman and Edwin M. Serrana (Edwin for brevity) as shown in his Certificate of Live Birth; his mother was never married to

his father at the time he was born and has never been married; since Nathaniel was born out of wedlock, he is an illegitimate child of Leah and Edwin; at the time of Nathaniel's birth, he was acknowledged by his father; hence the surname indicated in his birth certificate is the same as that of the father; unfortunately, Edwin and Leah's relationship turned sour; consequently, Edwin decided to leave Leah and Nathaniel and from then on up to present, Edwin failed to take up his responsibilities as a father on matters of financial, physical, emotional and spiritual concerns; despite the fact that Edwin left Leah and Nathaniel, the latter has been using the surname SERRANA since he was born; it is of common knowledge to the people who know Leah and Nathaniel that she has never been married and that there was no one who stood as a father to her child all these years as Nathaniel was raised by Leah alone; they never knew or only a few of them actually know the identity of her child's father; hence the use of different surname by the minor child has caused great confusion to the general public; people are confounded as to why the child bears a different surname from his mother; Nathaniel feels like an outcast from his mother and the rest of his relatives as though he does not belong to the family because of the difference in the surname; the mother and child are always propounded with questions as to why their surnames are different and it causes a great deal of embarrassment and ridicule to the mother and the child; this brings a negative impact on the child emotionally, not to mention the legal implications and troubles he may encounter in the future because of his different surname; if only Nathaniel will have a surname of his mother, all of these will be prevented and any other legal complications in the future will be avoided; Article 176 of the Executive Order No. 209, otherwise known as the Family Code of the Philippines provides that an illegitimate child shall use the surname of his or her mother; in addition, in the case of Republic of the Philippines versus Julian Edward Emerson Coseteng-Magpayo, the Supreme Court ruled that:

"A person can effect a change of name using valid meritorious grounds including (a) when the name is ridiculous, dishonorable or extremely difficult to write or pronounce; (b) when the change results as a legal consequence such as legitimation; (c) when the change will avoid confusion; (d) when one has continuously used and been known since childhood by a Filipino name, and was unaware of alien percentage; (e) a sincere desire to adopt a Filipino name to erase signs of former alienage, all in good faith and without prejudicing anybody; and (f) when the surname causes embarrassment and there is no showing that the desired change of name was for fraudulent purpose or that the change of name would prejudice public interest."

therefore, avoiding confusion and undue embarrassment on the part of both the mother and especially the child is the main thrust of this petition and solely filed in furtherance of the best interests of the minor child Nathaniel; accordingly, Section 2, Rule 108 of the Rules of Civil Procedure provides that: SP. "Section 2. Entries subject to cancellation or correction. — upon good and valid grounds, the following entries in the civil register may be cancelled or corrected: (a) births; (b) marriage; (c) deaths; (d) legal separations; (e) judgments of annulments of marriage; (f) judgments declaring marriages void from the beginning; (g) legitimations; (h) adoptions; (i) acknowledgments of natural children; (j) naturalization; (k) election, loss or recovery of citizenship; (l) civil interdiction; (m) judicial determination of filiation; (n) voluntary emancipation of a minor; and (o) changes of name."

moreover, Section 1, Rule 108 of the Rules of Civil Procedure provides that:

"Section 1. Who may file petition. Any person interested in any act, event order or decree concerning the civil status of persons which has been recorded in the civil register, may file a verified petition for the cancellation or correction of any entry relating thereto, with the Court of First Instance of the province where the corresponding registry is located."

hence, Rule 108 clearly directs that a petition which concerns one's civil status should be filed in the civil registry in which the entry sought to be cancelled or corrected, that of Malolos in the present case; and thus, this petition is filed with the Regional Trial Court of Malolos, Bulacan;

WHEREFORE, finding the Petition to be sufficient in form and substance, the same is hereby set for hearing on August 10, 2020 at 8:30 in the morning and all interested persons are hereby required to appear and show cause, if they have any, why the petition should not be granted.

Let copies of this Order be published, at the expense of the petitioner, in a newspaper of general circulation in the province of Bulacan for three (3) consecutive weeks, the last publication of which should be at least one (1) week before the date of hearing.

The Sheriff/Process Server of this court is hereby directed to post copies of this Order in the Bulletin board of this Court, at the Provincial Capitol of Bulacan, Malolos, Bulacan and Municipal Hall of Malolos City, Bulacan, for three (3) consecutive weeks prior to the date of hearing.
