ORDER

A verified *Petition for Recognition of Foreign Judgment (Divorce)* was filed on 23 December 2019 by petitioner *Ellen O. Dizon*, praying that after due notice and hearing, an order be issued recognizing the judgment of Divorce between petitioner *Ellen O. Dizon* and Respondent *Robert J. Jugo* as valid, declaring petitioner *Ellen O. Dizon* to be capacitated to remarry under Philippine law, ordering the Local Civil Registrar of Makati City, the Civil Registrar General, the Philippine Statistics Authority, and other concerned Philippine Government offices to annotate the divorce decree on the Certificate of Marriage of the parties, and to register and record the judgment of divorce of this Honorable Court in this Petition.

In the petition, it is alleged that sometime in October 1982, petitioner *Ellen O. Dizon* and respondent *Robert J. Jugo* met in Pasig City where they eventually became a couple. They had a long-distance relationship since respondent *Robert* worked overseas. After two years, they decided to tie the knot and have their own family. On 04 August 1984, *Ellen* and *Robert* married at the Saint John Bosco Church in Makati City, before Rev. Father *William Balocco, S.D.B.* as evidenced by a Marriage Contract with Register 84-1961. After getting married, the couple started living together at 394 A. Bonifacio Street Mandaluyong City where they were blessed with three children. Due to their frequent fighting, *Ellen* and *Robert* decided to migrate overseas for a fresh start and hoped for a renewed life together. In October 2005, the family migrated to Australia. However, on 18 February 2007, the marriage broke down completely after a major fight where petitioner suffered grave physical abuse. Due to their irreconcilable differences, the couple decided to separate on 21 March 2007. *Robert* moved out of the family's main house and transferred to the granny flat at the back of the house, while petitioner and their children stayed in the main house. In 2008, *Robert* had a difference, the couple decided to separate on 21 March 2007. *Robert* moved out of the family's main house and transferred to the granny flat at the back of the house, while petitioner and their children stayed in the main house. In 2008, *Robert* had a bypass operation which greatly weakened his health. This prompted their children to invite him to live back inside the main house, albeit in a separate room from petitioner. Considering that petitioner and respondent's relationship had broken down and could no longer be repaired, and since they had been living separate lives since 21 March 2007, the couple decided to jointly apply for divorce before the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong on December 1, 2008, pursuant to Section 48 of the Family Law Act 1975 of Australia. Based on the couple's Application for Divorce under File No. (P) DGC4131/2008, the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong issued a Certificate of Divorce in favor of *Ellen* and *Robert* on 14 January 2009 and took effect from 15 February 2009. In an effort to rekindle ties with her family in the Philippines, petitioner *Ellen* decided to reacquire her Philippine Citizenship. Accordingly, petitioner filed a petition for the Issuance of a Certificate of Retention/Reacquisition of Philippine Citizenship (CRPC) pursuant to

Republic Act (R.A. No. 9225) or the Citizenship Retention and Re-acquisition Act of 2003 in relation to Administrative Order No. 91, S. of 2004 and Memorandum Circular No. MCL-08-005 with the Embassy of the Philippines in Canberra Australia. On 6 February 2014, petitioner took her oath of allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines and was thereby deemed to have re-acquired her Philippine Citizenship. Thus, on February 18, 2014, her petition was granted by Embassy of the Philippines in Canberra in Order No. 14-9225-0067. Petitioner was then issued a Certificate of Retention/Re-acquisition of Philippine Citizenship No. 085-14.

Petitioner, **ELLEN O. DIZON** (formerly known as **ELLEN DIZON JUGO**),¹ by counsel, respectfully states:

I

THE PARTIES

1.1 Petitioner is of legal age, Filipino citizen, with residence address at 394 A. Bonifacio Street, Hagdan Bato, Libis, Mandaluyong City 1550. Petitioner may be served with notices and other legal processes of this Honorable Court through undersigned counsel at Unit 809 City & Land Mega Plaza Condominium, ADB Avenue, Ortigas Center Pasig City.

¹ Petitioner is formerly known under her married name ELLEN DIZON JUGO. However, pursuant to a Change of Name Certificate with Registration Number 60601/1959 N dated April 15, 2014, she has reverted to using her maiden name, ELLEN O. DIZON. 1.2 Respondent **ROBERT J. JUGO** ("Respondent Jugo") is of legal age, Australian citizen, with foreign address at 16 Conica Street Haliam Victoria 3803, Australia. He may be served with summons and other court processes of this Honorable Court at his local address at 42 Dr. Pilapil Street Sagad, Pasig City.

1.3 The other respondents, namely, the Local Civil Registrar of Makati City, the Civil Registrar General, the Philippine Statistics Authority, and all persons who have or claim any interest which would be affected by the outcome of this Petition are impleaded herein pursuant to Rule 108, Revised Rules of Court. They may be served with summons and other court processes of this Honorable Court through their respective offices.

II

ALLEGATIONS COMMON TO ALL CAUSES OF ACTION

2.1 Sometime in October 1982, petitioner and respondent *Jugo* met at the latter's residence in Pasig City where they eventually became a couple. They had long-distance relationship since respondent *Jugo* worked overseas. After two years, they decided to tie the knot and have their own family.

2.2 On August 4, 1984, petitioner and respondent *Jugo* married each other at the Saint John Bosco Church in Makati City before Rev. Father *William Balocco, S.D.B.* as evidenced by a Marriage Contract with Register No. 84-1961.

A certified true copy of the parties' Marriage Contract with Register No. 84-1961 issued by the Philippine Statistics Authority is attached and made integral part hereof as **Annex "B"**

2.3 After getting married, the couple started living together at 394 A. Bonifacio Street, Mandaluyong City, where they were blessed with three children.

2.4 Due to their frequent fighting, petitioner and respondent *Jugo* decided to migrate overseas for a fresh start and hoped for a renewed life together. In October 2005, the family migrated to Australia.

2.5 However, on February 18, 2007, the marriage broke down completely after a major fight where petitioner suffered grave physical abuse. Due to their irreconcilable differences, the couple decided to separate on March 21, 2007. Respondent *Jugo* moved out of the family's main house and transferred to the granny flat at the back of the house, while petitioner and their children stayed in the main house.

2.6 In January 2008, respondent *Jugo* had a bypass operation which greatly weakened his health. This prompted their children to invite him to live back inside the main house, albeit in a separate room from petitioner. 2.7 On February 28, 2008, petitioner acquired and was granted Australian citizenship by the Australian Minister for Immigration and Citizenship pursuant to the Australian Citizenship Act 2007, as evidenced by the Australian Citizenship certificate with Evidence No. 01490502703.

A photocopy of the apostilled Australian Citizenship certificate with Evidence No. 01490502703 certified by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade, Melbourne, Australia is attached and made integral part hereof as **Annex "C"**.

2.8 Considering that petitioner and respondent *Jugo*'s relationship had broken down irretrievably and could no longer be repaired, and since they had been living separate lives since March 21, 2007. The couple decided to jointly apply for divorce before the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong on December 1, 2008, pursuant to Section 48 of the Family Law Act 1975 of Australia.

A photocopy of the pertinent provisions of the Family Law Act 1975 of Australia, specifically Section 48 to 59 thereof, apostilled and certified by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade Melbourne, Australia is attached and made integral part hereof as **Annex "D"**. A photocopy of the Application for Divorce with File No. DGC4131/2008 dated December 1, 2008, accomplished and signed by both petitioner and respondent *Jugo*, is attached and made integral part hereof as **Annex "E"**

2.9 Based on the couple's Application for Divorce under File No. (P) DGC4131/2008, the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong issued a Certificate of Divorce in favor of petitioner and respondent *Jugo* on January 14, 2009 and took effect from February 15, 2009.

A photocopy of the apostilled Certificate of Divorce under File No. (P) DGC4131/2008 the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong issued a Certificate of Divorce in favor of petitioner and respondent *Jugo* on January 14, 2009 and took effect from February 15, 2009.

A photocopy of the apostilled Certificate of Divorce under File No. (P) DGC4131/2008, certified by the Department of Foreign Affairs and Trade Melbourne, Australia is attached and made integral part hereof as **Annex "F"**.

2.10 In an effort to rekindle ties with her family in the Philippines petitioner decided to reacquire her Philippine Citizenship. Accordingly, petitioner filed a Petition for the Issuance of a Certificate of Retention/Reacquisition of Philippine Citizenship (CRPC) pursuant to Republic Act (R.A.) No. 9225 or the Citizenship Retention and Re-acquisition Act of 2003 in relation to Administrative Order No. 91, S. of 2004 and Memorandum Circular No. MCL-08-005 with the Embassy of the Philippines in Canberra Australia.

2.11 On February 6, 2014, petitioner took her oath of allegiance to the Republic of the Philippines and was thereby deemed to have re-acquired her Philippine Citizenship. Thus, on February 18, 2014, her petition was

granted by Embassy of the Philippines in Canberra in Order No. 14-9225-0067. Petitioner was then issued a certificate of Retention/Re-acquisition of Philippine Citizenship No. 085-14.

Photocopies of the certified true copies of petitioner's certificate of Retention/Re-acquisition of Philippine Citizenship No. 085-14, Order No. 14-9225-0067 dated February 18, 2014, and Oath of Allegiance dated February 6, 2014 are attached and made integral parts hereof as **Annexes "G", "G-1" and "G-2"**.

III

FIRST CAUSE OF ACTION

3.1 The foregoing allegations are repleaded herein by reference.

3.2 The second paragraph of Article 26 of the Family Code, as amended, states:

Where a marriage between a Filipino citizen and a foreigner is validly celebrated and a divorce is thereafter validly obtained abroad by the alien spouse capacitating him or her to remarry, the Filipino spouse shall have capacity to remarry under Philippine law. (As amended by Executive Order 227)

3.3 In *Gerbert R. Corpuz v. Daisylyn Tirol Sto. Tomas and the Solicitor General*² ("Corpuz Case"), the Supreme Court reiterated the rationale of the above-quoted provision in this wise:

xxx the provision was included in the law "to avoid the absurd situation where the Filipino spouse remains married to the alien spouse who, after obtaining a divorce, is no longer married to the Filipino spouse." The legislative intent is for the benefit of the Filipino spouse, by clarifying his or her marital status, settling the doubts created by the divorce decree. Essentially, the second paragraph of Article 26 of the Family Code provided the Filipino spouse a substantive right to have his or her marriage to the alien spouse considered as dissolved, capacitating him or her to remarry. Without the second paragraph of Article 26 of the Family Code, the judicial recognition of the foreign decree of divorce whether in a proceeding instituted precisely for the purpose or as a related issue in another proceeding, would be of no significance to the Filipino spouse since our laws do not recognize divorce as a mode of severing the marital bond; Article 17 of the Civil Code provides that the policy against absolute divorces cannot be subverted by judgments promulgated in foreign country. The inclusion of the second paragraph in Article 26 of the Family Code provides the direct exception of this rule and serves as basis for recognizing the dissolution of the marriage between the Filipino spouse and his or her alien spouse.

² G.R. No. 186571, August 11, 2010

Additionally, an action based on the second paragraph of Article 26 of the Family Code is not limited to the recognition of the foreign divorce decree. If the court finds that the decree capacitated the alien spouse to remarry, the courts can declare that the Filipino spouse is likewise capacitated to contract another marriage. No court in this jurisdiction, however, can make a similar declaration for the alien spouse (other than that already established by the decree), whose status and legal capacity are generally governed by his national law.

3.4 Applying the foregoing, petitioner therefore has the right to have the divorce which they obtained abroad to be recognized in the Philippines.

3.5 Furthermore, Section 59 of the Family Law Act 1975 of Australia allows the parties subject of a divorce order to marry again once the divorce order has taken effect.³

3.6 Considering that the divorce has capacitated both parties to remarry under the Family Law Act 1975 of Australia, it is respectfully submitted that petitioner should likewise be declared capacitated to remarry under Philippine law.

IV

SECOND CAUSE OF ACTION

4.1 The foregoing allegations are repleaded herein by reference.

4.2 Article 412 of the Civil Code declares that "no entry in a civil register shall be changed or corrected, without judicial order." Rule 108 of the Revised Rules of Court provides for the special remedial proceeding by which entries in the civil registry may be judicially cancelled or corrected or for a judgment, authorizing the cancellation or correction, may be annotated in the civil registry.

4.3 For the divorce secured by the parties in Australia to be properly recognized in this jurisdiction and for such recognition be duly annotated in the civil registry and the corresponding entries as to the civil status of the petitioner be accordingly cancelled or corrected and having complied with the requirements, petitioner is filing instant petition under Rule 108 of the Revised Rules of Court.

If a divorce under this Act in relation to a marriage has taken effect, a party to the marriage may marry again (See Annex "D" page 6 of this Petition).

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, petitioner *ELLEN O. DIZON* (formerly known as *ELLEN DIZON JUGO*) respectfully prays that this Honorable Court render judgment as follows:

1. Recognizing in this jurisdiction the divorce between petitioner *ELLEN O. DIZON* and respondent *ROBERT J. JUGO* on January 14, 2009, evidenced by a Certificate of Divorce under File No. (P) DGC4131/2008, granted by the Federal Magistrates Court of Australia at Dandenong, as valid;
2. Declaring the marital bond between the parties severed as a result thereof and de-

claring petitioner *ELLEN O. DIZON* to be capacitated to remarry under Philippine law;

3. Ordering the Local Civil Registrar of Makati City, the Civil Registrar General, the Philippine Statistics Authority, and other concerned Philippine Government offices to annotate the divorce decree on the Certificate of Marriage of the parties; and

4. Ordering the Local Civil Registrar of Makati City, the Civil Registrar General, the Philippine Statistics Authority and other concerned Philippine Government offices to register and record the judgment (recognizing the divorce) of this Honorable Court in this Petition. COMPLAINT

Plaintiff **RURAL BANK OF LIPA CITY, INC.** by counsel, respectfully states:

1. Plaintiff **RURAL BANK OF LIPA CITY, INC.** is a corporation engaged primarily in the business of banking. Its principal office address is at 113 J.P. Rizal St., Lipa City, Batangas. It may be served summons and other processes of this Honorable Court at undersigned counsel's address.

2. Defendant **PAXTON DEVELOPMENT CORPORATION ("PDC")** is a corporation engaged primarily in the real estate business. Its principal office address is at Stanford Tower Condominium, 1870 M.H. Del Pilar St., Malate Manila where it may be served with summons and other processes of this Honorable Court.

3. Defendant **GEORGE UY SO** is a Filipino, of legal age, and the Executive Vice President of Defendant PDC at the time that the loan was obtained. In his personal capacity, he signed a Promissory Note dated 7 March 2008 to secure the loan of Defendant PDC. He may be served with summons and other processes of this Honorable Court at 149 Roxas Boulevard corner Airport Road, Paranaque City.

4. Defendant **PAZ A. FORES** is a Filipino, of legal age, and the co-maker of the loan obtained by Defendant PDC. She signed a Real Estate Mortgage dated 21 February 2008 as co-maker and guarantor of the loan of Defendant PDC. She may be served with summons and other processes of this Honorable Court at Unit 1203 Chateau de Baie Condominium No. 149 Roxas Boulevard corner Airport Road, Paranaque City.

5. On 7 March 2008, Defendant PDC, through its Executive Vice President and Treasurer, Defendant George Uy So obtained a loan from Plaintiff in the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (Php15,000,000.00), payable in five (5) years with a monthly amortization of Two Hundred Eighty Nine Thousand Eight Hundred Ninety Pesos (Php289,890.00). A copy of the loan agreement (untitled) is attached hereto as **Annex "A"**.

6. In order to obtain said loan, Defendant George Uy So presented the Minutes of the Special Meeting of the Board of Directors of Defendant PDC dated 25 February 2008 and a Secretary's Certificate issued by one Alejandro P. Ruiz, Corporate Secretary of Defendant PDC, showing Mr. So's authority to obtain a loan for and on behalf of Defendant PDC. Attached hereto as **Annexes "B" and "C"** are the Secretary's Certificate and Minutes, respectively.

7. To secure the loan, Defendant So, in his personal capacity, executed Promissory Note No. 3264 in favor of the Plaintiff. A copy of the Promissory Note is attached hereto as **Annex "D"**.

8. Defendants likewise executed a Real Estate Mortgage ("REM") over a 41,495 square meter lot of Defendant Fores through Transfer Certificate of Title No. 193171 located in Bo. Malilit, Sta. Rosa Laguna. A copy of the Real Estate Mortgage is attached hereto as **Annex "E"**.

8.01. Defendant PDC was able to execute a Real Estate Mortgage ("REM") over the property of one Paz Fores after the latter executed a Special Power of Attorney Coupled with Interest dated 21 February 2008 in favor of Defendant PDC. A copy of the Special Power of Attorney Coupled with Interest dated 21 February 2008 is attached hereto as **Annex "F"**.

8.02. In the REM dated 21 February 2008, Defendant So and Fores both warranted that Fores is the absolute owner of the property and that the same is free from all liens and encumbrances.

8.03. Defendant So convinced the Bank officers that Defendant Fores was willing to have her property serve as collateral for the loan out of gratitude to Defendant So. Allegedly, Defendant So financed Defendant Fores' medical trip in the United States. With these representations, the Bank agreed to accept the property as collateral for the loan and facilitated the real estate mortgage over the property.

9. Plaintiff then conducted an appraisal of the property in December 2007. In his report, Plaintiff's appraiser stated that TCT No. 193171 has been verified with the Register of Deeds, that the taxes due on the subject property were paid, and that the property is a residential vacant lot with a developed concrete road. Considering the prime location of the subject property, Plaintiff appraised the property at Seventy Five Million Five Hundred One Thousand Pesos (Php75,501,000.00). Attached as **Annex "G"** is the Appraisal Report dated 12 December 2007.

10. Plaintiff likewise hired an independent appraiser, Cuervo and Associates, which appraised the subject property to be worth One Hundred Four Million Eight Hundred Sixty Two Thousand Five Hundred Pesos (Php104,862,500.00). Attached as **Annex "H"** is the Appraisal Report dated 10 January 2008.

11. Thinking that the collateral mortgaged to them is actually of value, Plaintiff sought the registration of the REM with the Register of Deeds of Laguna and believed that the REM was registered because it was annotated at the back of the owner's duplicate certificate of title in the possession of the Bank. However, Plaintiff discovered later that the REM was not annotated on the TCT on file with the Register of Deeds of Laguna.

12. Meanwhile, Defendant PDC paid the first six monthly amortizations but thereafter defaulted on the remainder. Thus, on 29 January 2009, Plaintiff sent a final demand letter to Defendant PDC, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Annex "I"**.

13. Despite receipt of said demand letter, Defendant PDC failed to pay its outstanding obligation to Plaintiff.

14. Thus, on 21 February 2013, Plaintiff filed a Petition for Extra-Judicial Foreclosure of the Real Estate Mortgage which was eventually granted by the Regional Trial Court of Biñan City, Laguna. A Notice of Extrajudicial Sale dated 21 February 2013 is attached hereto as **Annex "J"**.

15. The public auction was held on 8 May 2013 where Plaintiff was declared as the winning bidder.

16. Plaintiff then proceeded to cause the annotation of the Certificate of Sale at the back of TCT No. T-193171 with the Register of Deeds of Laguna.

17. However, the Register of Deeds of Laguna informed Plaintiff that it cannot do so anymore since TCT No. T-193171 was already cancelled way back in 2010 and the property is now covered by TCT No. 060-2014015965. Thus the extrajudicial foreclosure of the property was not completed.

18. Plaintiff investigated the cancellation of TCT No. T-193171 and found out that the records of the Register of Deeds show that on 25 November 2003, TCT No. T-193171 was declared lost and a second owner's duplicate certificate - TCT No. (T-193171) 589062- was issued. However, TCT No. (T-193171) 589062 was cancelled in lieu thereof, TCT No. T-770478 was issued in favor of Carmen Y. Fores and Ma. Beatriz Y. Fores, pursuant to an extra-judicial settlement of estate executed by the legal heirs of Paz Y. Fores in 2007. The records also show that on 02 June 2014, Carmen and Beatriz sold the subject property to Global Summit Property Development Corporation for Twenty Four Million Pesos (P24,000,000.00). The subject property is now covered by TCT No. 060-2014015965 in the name Global

Summit Property Development Corporation.

19. Plaintiff then realized that the owner's duplicate copy of TCT No. T-193171 submitted to them by Defendants So and Fores is a fake. As was mentioned earlier, as early as 2003, the authentic owners duplicate copy of TCT No. T-193171 was already declared lost and a second owner's duplicate certificate - TCT No. (T-193171) 589062 was eventually issued thereafter.

20. Thus, on 27 March 2015, Plaintiff sent Defendant PDC a final demand letter dated 26 March 2015, a copy of which is attached hereto as **Annex "K"**.

21. Plaintiff tried to locate the signatories to the mortgage, namely, Defendants So and Fores at their declared addresses but they could not be located. Plaintiff was also informed that the office of Paxton is no longer at the address it declared in its loan application.

22. Clearly, Defendants, in conspiracy with one another, has defrauded Plaintiff of millions of pesos through the aforementioned loan which was secured by fake collateral.

23. To date, Defendants' obligation remains unpaid despite repeated demands from Plaintiff.

24. In view of the foregoing, Defendants should be ordered to pay Complainant the principal loan in the amount of Fifteen Million Pesos (Php15,000,000.00), exclusive of interest and penalties, less the first six monthly amortizations in the amount of One Million Seven Hundred Thirty Nine Thousand Three Hundred Forty Pesos (Php1,739,340.00) or a total amount of Thirteen Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Pesos (Php13,260,660.00)

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, it is most respectfully prayed that:

After due hearing, this Honorable Court render judgment in favor or Plaintiff ordering Defendants to pay the following amounts:

- (1) **Thirteen Million Two Hundred Sixty Thousand Six Hundred Sixty Pesos** (Php13,260,660.00) representing the principal amount of the loan less the first six monthly amortizations plus interest from time of demand; and
- (2) Litigation expenses and costs of suit.

Plaintiff likewise prays for such further or other reliefs as may be deemed just or equitable.
