ORDINANCE NO. 1017, Series of 2022
AN ORDINANCE DEPUTIZING AS DEVELOPMENT PARTNERS IN MAINTAINING ORDER ALL HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION, AS REPRESENTED BY THEIR DULY-ELECTED OFFICERS, DULY ACCREDITED BY THE CITY COUNCIL AND RECOGNIZED BY THE CITY HOUSING RESETTLEMENT OFFICE (HRO) IN THE IDENTIFIED HOUSING PROJECTS LOCATED IN EXPROPRIATED PROPERTIES OF THE CITY GOVERNMENT OF VALENZUELA AND FOR OTHER PURPOSES.

SECTION 1. TITLE. – This Ordinance shall be known as the "City Government of Valenzuela and Homeowners' Associations Partnership in Expropriated Properties Ordinance".

SECTION 2. DECLARATION OF POLICY.

SECTION 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

SECTION 4. PARTNERSHIP BETWEEN THE CITY GOVERNMENT AND THE HOMEOWNERS' ASSOCIATION (HOA). – Duly accredited and recognized homeowners' associations shall be partners of the City Government in the management of its expropriated properties and maintaining order in the communities situated therein.

Homeowners' associations shall complement, support and strengthen the City in providing vital services to their members and help implement local government policies, programs, ordinances, and rules.

Associations are encouraged to actively cooperate in partnership with the City in furtherance of their common goals and activities for the benefit of the residents of the communities/housing projects and their environs.

SECTION 5. CONDITIONAL USE OF EXPROPRIATED PROPERTIES. -As condition for the continued use of the City-owned expropriated properties, the respective homeowners' association of each housing project/community located in expropriated lands of the City Government of Valenzuela shall maintain close coordination with the City Government. The City Government shall continue to exercise control and supervision over its subject expropriated properties in partnership with the respective homeowners' associations in the said properties.

SECTION 6. REGISTRATION WITH THE DEPARTMENT OF HUMAN SETTLEMENTS AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (DHSUD) FORMERLY KNOWN AS THE HLURB. – Every association of homeowners shall be registered with the DHSUD. This registration shall serve to grant juridical personality to all such associations that have not previously acquired the same by operation of the General Corporation Law or by any other general law.

SECTION 7. REGISTRATION WITH THE CITY. – In addition to its registration with the DHSUD, all associations of homeowners located in expropriated property of the City, or in every housing project located in expropriated property of the City shall be duly recognized by the City Housing Resettlement Office (HRO) and duly accredited by the Sangguniang Panlungsod.

SECTION 8. HOA BYLAWS.No Association under this Ordinance shall be recognized by the City Government of Valenzuela without an association bylaws duly adopted by a simple majority of the members of the association during its General Assembly. Consistent with the provisions of Republic Act No. 9904 and its IRR, it shall provide for:

- (a) The qualifications, rights, duties and obligations of members;
- (b) The circumstances under which membership is acquired, maintained, and lost;
- (c) The grounds and procedure by which members are declared delinquent or not in good standing, the penalties and sanctions imposable on a delinquent member or a member not in good standing, and the manner or procedure through which the declaration may be lifted and the member restored to good standing;
- (d) The schedule, venue, and manner of conducting the regular, special, and emergency meetings of the general membership, the required quorum, and allowable proxies in such meetings;
- (e) The date for holding the regular election of trustees or directors and the mode or manner of giving notice thereof;
- (f) The number, qualifications, powers and duties, terms of office, manner of electing and removing the board and the filling of vacancies in the board: Provided, That the term of office of the members of the board shall not exceed two (2) years;
- (g) The qualifications, positions, duties, election or appointment, and compensation of other officers and employees of the association: Provided, That the term of office of the other officers shall not exceed two (2) years: Provided, further, That no officer of the association, holding a rank of director or trustee shall likewise be entitled to any compensation;

(h) The grounds and procedure for removal of trustee or director and/or officer, and the manner of filling of vacancies in the Board, consistent with Section 13 of Republic Act No. 9904;

(i) The grounds and procedure for dissolution of the board, and the manner of reconstituting the board, consistent with Sections 13 and 14 of this Republic Act No. 9904;

(j) The actions for limiting, broadening or denying the right to vote, and the extent thereof;

(k) The officer(s) authorized to prepare, execute, certify and record amendments to the governing documents on behalf of the association;

(l) The designation of the presiding officer at meetings of directors or trustees and members;(m) Such powers that the board may delegate to a managing agent, if any, or to other persons;

(n) The time for holding the regular election of directors or trustees and the mode or manner of giving notice thereof;

(o) The creation of election, grievance and audit committees, and such other committees which the association may deem necessary; as well as a conciliation or mediation mechanism for the amicable settlement of disputes among members, directors or trustees, officers and committee members of the association;

(p) The dues, fees, and special assessments to be imposed on a regular basis, and the manner in which the same may be imposed and/or increased;

(q) The procedure in adopting, amending, repealing and abrogating the bylaws;

(r) The list of acts constituting a violation by its officers and the corresponding penalties therefor;

(s) The imposable penalties for violation of particular provisions of the bylaws; and

(t) Such other matters necessary for the proper or convenient transaction of its corporate business and affairs.

SECTION 9. REPORTORIAL DUTY OF HOA TO THE HRO.– All accredited and recognized homeowners' associations shall submit to the HRO within forty eight (48) hours from approval a copy of every board resolution duly approved in a General Assembly in accordance with its adopted bylaws.

SECTION 10. REVIEW OF BOARD RESOLUTIONS. - All board resolutions in the preceding section shall be subject to review by the HRO for consistency with laws, rules and regulations, and City ordinances and to determine necessity of the board resolution. The HRO shall submit to the Local Chief Executive a copy of all reviewed board resolutions for his written conformity.

SECTION 11. CONFORME OF THE LOCAL CHIEF EXECUTIVE AND EFFECTIVITY OF BOARD RESOLUTIONS. - No board resolution may take effect without the written conforme of the Local Chief Executive. The Local Chief Executive may signify his conformity with the board resolution by affixing his signature to the copy of the board resolution. After which, the HRO shall return such copy of the concerned HOA a copy of the board resolution.

No board resolutions which are illegal, invalid, unnecessary and/or disadvantageous to the City Government shall take effect.

SECTION 12. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY. – The City Housing and Resettlement Office, their authorized personnel, and other personnel deputized by the Local Chief Executive shall be tasked to implement the provision of this Ordinance.

SECTION 13. IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATION. – While provisions of this Ordinance may be validly implemented immediately, the Local Chief Executive may issue Implementing Rules and Regulations for its effective implementation, if necessary.

SECTION 14. SEPARABILITY CLAUSE.

SECTION 15. REPEALING CLAUSE.

SECTION 16. EFFECTIVITY. - This Ordinance shall take effect immediately upon approval.
