Before this Court is the Motion to Allow Service of Summons by Publication filed by plaintiff, through Atty. Jocelyn A. Ong, alleging that despite diligent efforts to locate the defendant, her whereabouts, remain uncertain.

Finding the grounds relied upon impressed with merit, the Motion to Allow Service of Summons by Publication is hereby granted.

Accordingly, let the summons on defendant Janeath De Paula, together with a copy of the complaint, be published in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks.

Defendant is given a period of sixty (60) days counted from the last date of publication to file its responsive pleading attaching the necessary appendage thereto.

COMPLAINT

PLAINTIFF, by counsel, to this Honorable Court, respectfully alleges:

1. That plaintiff Alejandro Cruz Padua Dela Cruz Corp. is a domestic corporation duly formed and organized under the laws of the Philippines and herein represented by Herbert C. Maranan, as shown by the Secretary's Certificate as **Annex "A"** and made integral part hereof. Plaintiff may be served with summons, notices and processes of this Honorable Court at its official business address at 2039 G.G. Cruz, Baclaran St., Parañaque City where it may be served with copies of the pleadings and court processes.

2. Defendant Janeath De Paula is of legal age, Filipino and may be notified at B7 L31 Pedro Sabido Street, BFRV Las Piñas City and J1-B No. 2955 Aguarrá St., Baclaran, Parañaque City where she may be served with summons and copy of the complaint;

3. This action includes as defendants all persons claiming rights under her or any and all occupants of the subject premises.

FACTS

4. Plaintiff is the owner of a commercial area (J1-Stall B) located at Tuding Market No. 2955 Aguarrá Street, Baclaran Parañaque City as evidenced by **Transfer Certificate of Title and Real Property Tax Receipt as Annexes "B" and "C" respectively**;

5. That on May 17, 2021, plaintiff and the defendant Janeath De Paula entered into a contract of lease over J1 Stall B No. 2955 Aguarrá St. Baclaran, Parañaque City. Attached herewith is the copy of said contract of lease as **Annex "D"** and made integral part hereof.

6. However, the defendant failed to make timely payments of her rental fees to the plaintiff from the month of September 2022 until the present now amounting to **Php 150,000.00**. Worst, she can no longer be located in the premises and had allowed other people to use the same without asking the consent of the Plaintiff.

7. The fact of non payment of rent is evidenced by the notice to pay or quit sent last March 10, 2022; May 10, 2022; May 17, 2022 and June 1, 2022 as well as the checks that bounced. Copy of the notices to pay or quit are hereto attached as **Annex "E"** to **"H"** and the checks that bounced are hereto attached as **Annexes "I" to "M"**.

8. On November 15, 2022, plaintiff, through its counsel sent defendant a demand letter, demanding payment of her rental in arrears in the total amount of Php 66,042.84 and for her to vacate the leased premises. The rental in arrears were only for two months, from September and October 2022.

The demand letter was sent at the residence of Defendant and at the place which she is renting. This is evidenced by the registry receipts. Aside from sending the letter through registered mail, the same was sent through LBC. The letters sent through registered mail were returned with the notation "Unknown". As to the letters sent through LBC, the same carried the notation "Moved Out".

Copy of the demand letter dated November 15, 2022 is hereto attached as Annex "N", the registry receipts as Annexes "N" and "N-1"; the returned letters are hereto attached as Annexes "N- 2" and the returned letters from LBC are hereto attached as Annexes "N-3" and "N-4".

9. Clearly, the letter was sent through registered mail and courier service to the defendant and to all the persons claiming rights under her were returned due to the fact that Defendant can no longer be located. However, in the premises left by the Defendants are several furniture and fixtures which cannot be touched by the Plaintiff.

10. Thus, defendant already breached her rental agreement with the plaintiff by not paying the rental arrears and vacating the premises despite formal demand. Vacating should include moving all the furniture and fixture in the premises.

11. That as of February 17, 2023, the accumulated monthly rentals in arrears of defendant has reached **Php 150,000.00**;

12. That by reason of defendant's continuous refusal to pay and vacate the premises, plaintiff suffered and will continue to suffer damages in the form of unpaid rentals and unlawful possession of the property;

13. That plaintiff filed the present case within one-year from the demand letter. The Plaintiff being a corporation need not go through the barangay.

14. Further, it is seeking for the Defendant to vacate the premises for she had left all her belongings in the rented area and this is evidenced by the attached pictures as **Annexes "O" to "O-15"**.

15. Due to the unjustified act of the defendant, plaintiff was constrained to hire the services of the undersigned counsel at an agreed

amount of P30,000.00 as attorney's fees and a per court appearance of P5,000.00.

16. To deter others from committing a similar malicious act, defendants should be liable to pay exemplary damages in an amount not less than P50,000.00.

17. The plaintiff will be presenting the following documentary evidence to wit:

- Transfer Certificate of Title
- Real Property Tax Receipt
- Contract of lease
- Notices to pay or quit
- Checks
- Demand letter dated November 15, 2022

18. Only one witness will be presented under this case: Herbert C. Maranan who will testify on what had transpired throughout the stay of the defendant in the property up until the demand for them to vacate the same, he will likewise identify all the documents to be presented.

PRAYER


WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed of this Honorable Court that judgment be rendered in favor of the plaintiff and against the defendant by:

- Ordering the defendant Janeath De Paula and all other persons claiming rights under her to vacate peacefully the premises and to surrender possession thereof to the plaintiff;
- Ordering the defendant to pay plaintiff her unpaid rentals from September 18, 2022 to February 17, 2023 amounting to Php 150,000.00 and thereafter, the monthly rent of Php25,000.00 until the subject premises is peacefully surrendered and restored to the plaintiff.
- Ordering the defendant to pay the plaintiff the following:
 - Exemplary damages-P50,000.00
 - Attorney's fees-P30,000.00 and P5,000.00 every hearing
 - To pay cost of suit.
