He has resided continuously in the Philippines for a period of 48 years. The date of arrival is indicated in the Alien Certification of Registration (ACR) issued on 5 May 1976. He then applied and was issued an ACR and an ACR Card on 4 October 2022. He was given Study Permit of Foreign Student dated 8 June 1976. He studied his elementary education at COWHM Memorial School with address at Binondo, Manila. In 1979 to 1984, he continued his studies and completed his Secondary Education at St. Stephen's High School with address at 1267 Guillermo Masangkay St., Manila. In 1984 to 1988, he studied at De La Salle University where he obtained a college degree of Bachelor of Science in Industrial Engineering and Management. He was married to Ann Marie Chua Tan-Ting, a Filipino citizen, on 28 November 1988. They begot a child named Aidan Matthew Ting, who was born on 25 September 2006 at Quezon City and enrolled as Grade 11 student of Xavier School San Juan with address at 64 Xavier, San Juan City.
