### ORDER NATURE OF THE PETITION

A verified petition for declaration of nullity of marriage under Article 35 of the Family Code has been filed by KATE CONCEPCION TORIO (hereinafter, Kate), Filipino, of legal age, married to Respondent, and a resident of Purok 4, Road 4, Villa Celia Village, Kumintang Ilaya, Batangas City, against JEFFREY ARISTORENAS TORIO (hereinafter, Jeffrey) likewise a Filipino and of legal age and with last known address at 245 Emilia Compound, M. Dela Fuente St., Sampaloc Manila

### PRINCIPAL GROUNDS OF THE PETITION

As alleged in the Petition, Kate Concepcion Torio married to respondent Jeffrey Aristorenas Torio while in the process of filing to file a petition to declare her marriage null and void came to know from her counsel that her husband has a prior existing marriage when counsel in the exercise of due diligence, obtained a CENOMAR from the PSA. Said PSA advisory on marriage (CRS form 5) reflected that Jeffrey Aristorenas Torio has a prior existing marriage to one Desiree Joy Cabusao Palacio celebrated on 08 August 2005 at San Jose Del Monte Bulacan. Said marriage of respondent, Jeffrey Aristorenas Torio was celebrated prior to his marriage to herein Petitioner Kate Concepcion Torio on 20 April 2007 at New Manila Philippines. As of the filing of the Petition, Desiree Joy Cabusao Palacio, the wife of respondent from his previous marriage is still alive as evidenced by her recent and dated social media (Facebook) post.

### RELIEFS PRAYED FOR

Petitioner prays that after due proceedings: 1.) her marriage to the Respondent Jeffrey Aristorenas Torio celebrated on 20 April 2007 be declared null and void on the ground of Respondent's prior subsisting marriage to one Desiree Joy Cabusao Palacio on August 8, 2005 and; 2) for such other reliefs just and equitable under existing laws and jurisprudence.

### DIRECTIVE

Respondent, JEFFREY ARISTORENAS TORIO, is hereby directed to file with the Clerk of Court of the Regional Trial Court, Branch 1, Batangas City, within thirty (30) days from the last issue of publication, exclusive of the day of such last publication, his "Answer" to the Petition filed, and to serve a copy of the said "Answer" with the same period upon Petitioner.
