He is not a polygamist or a believer in the practice of polygamy. He is not suffering from mental alienation or any incurable contagious disease. He is a citizen of a nation that is not at war with the Philippines. It is his intention in good faith to become a citizen of the Philippines and to renounce absolutely and forever all allegiance and fidelity to any foreign state or sovereignty and particularly the China which at this time he is a citizen. This is evidenced by the **Original Copies of the Transcript of Records, Certificate of Graduation, and Certified True Copy of the Diploma** issued by the St. Stephen's Highschool are hereto attached as **Annexes "E", "F" and "G"** respectively.

9.
