WHEREFORE, let Summons by publication be effected upon the said defendants once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines.

Defendants **Tida Acang, William Parec, Marilyn Parec, Felisa Paragua and Ambrosio Rapal** are hereby summoned and directed to file their Answer to the Complaint with the Regional Trial Court (RTC), Branch 12, Sanchez Mira, Cagayan, within sixty (60) days from the last publication of this order.

The Complaint alleges:

1. Plaintiffs **HEIRS OF DELFINA BATARA** namely **CARMEN GARRO-GERARDO, CHRISTIAN G. GERARDO, CAROLYN G. GERARDO** are all of legal age, Filipinos, and residents of Dana-Ili, Abulug, Cagayan where they may be served with notices and other legal processes of this Honorable Court.
2. Plaintiffs **HEIRS OF JOSE B. DAGUNA** represented by **ALEXANDER STACY DAGUNA** who is of legal age, Filipino a resident of Centro, Pamplona Cagayan where he may be served with notices and other legal processes of this Honorable Court.
3. On the other hand, defendants, **JOCELYN ACANG** and **TIDA ACANG** are of legal age, Filipinos and residents of Brgy. Centro, Pamplona, Cagayan, where they may be served with summons and legal processes of this Honorable Court.
4. Defendants **MELVIN AURELLANO, MARICEL MALLAZAB, ERNESTO DELA FUENTE, ROSALIA PAGARAN, FELISA PARAGUA, FE MADRIAGA, HOLLY MEDRANO, AMBROSIO RAPAL and ROD BUDUAN** are all of legal age, Filipinos and residents of Brgy. Sta. Cruz, Pamplona, Cagayan, where they may be served with summons and legal processes of this Honorable Court.
5. Defendants **ELPIDIO UBIAS, BENJAMIN BIELZA, CARMENCITA BIELZA, SAMUEL BIELZA, MAXIMINO BARCENA, ROBERTO BARCENA, MARILYN PAREC, WILLIAM PAREC, ELVIS SEMANA, ORLANDO RINGOR, JOEL CENAL, MARTINA CENAL, CHRISTOPHER MARIANO, BALDOMERO RAMBAYON** are likewise of legal age, Filipinos and residents of Brgy. Curva, Pamplona, Cagayan, where they may be served with summons and legal processes of this Honorable Court.
6. Delfina Batara is the registered owner of a parcel of land situated in Brgy. Curva, Pamplona, Cagayan (formerly Sitio Carallan, Pamplona, Cagayan) consisting of approximately TWO HUNDRED THIRTY NINE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND THIRTY SIX (239,936) square meters, identified as lot 3163-B and covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-2394(s) of the Registry of Deeds of Sanchez Mira. A copy of said title is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "A"**.
7. The above-mentioned title traces its origin from Original Certificate of Title no. (7782) 904 which was originally registered under the name of Pedro Gerardo, the deceased husband of Delfina Batara. A copy of said OCT is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "B"**.
8. During the lifetime of Pedro and Delfina, they have been occupying and tilling this land together with their three (3) children, namely, **ORLINO BATARA GERARDO, FELICITO BATARA GERARDO** and **FELISA BATARA GERARDO**.
9. On 01 August 1955, Pedro Gerardo died and his wife, Delfina succeeded him, hence,

- a new title was issued in her favor-TCT No. T-344. A copy of said TCT No. T-344 is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "C"**. Likewise, a copy of Pedro's Death Certificate is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "D"**.
10. TCT No. T-344 was subsequently cancelled when Delfina allegedly sold the property to Atty. Bienvenido Cactian. Hence TCT No. 358 was issued in favor of the latter. A copy of said TCT No. 358 is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "E"**.
 11. Atty. Bienvenido Cactian mortgaged said property but after fulfilling his obligation to the mortgage contract, he executed a Deed of Sale in favor of Delfina, hence the TCT No.358 was cancelled and a new one was issued, TCT No. T-2394(s), again under the name of Delfina.
 12. On 12 March 1973, an undivided half portion of said property was sold by Delfina. To Jose B. Daguna, Sr. who died intestate sometime in 1993. Thus, his heirs succeeded and they are represented by their attorney-in- fact, Alexander S. Daguna. A copy of a Special Power of Attorney is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "F"**. A copy of the Deed of Sale dated 12 March 1973 is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "G"**.
 13. Since then, real property taxes were paid by Jose B. Daguna and petitioner Alexander S. Daguna. Copies of the Tax Declaration and receipt are attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "H"** and **"I-1"** which indicate that the current assessed value of said lot amounts to FOUR HUNDRED THOUSAND AND EIGHT HUNDRED FIFTY Pesos (Php 400, 850.00).
 14. Delfina and her children transferred residence in Dana-Ili Abulug after the death of Pedro.
 15. On 05 May 1999, Felisa Batara Gerardo died and predeceased Delfina. A copy of her Certificate of Death is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "I"**. Likewise a copy of her Cenomar is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "J"**.
 16. On 19 February 2002, Delfina died intestate with two surviving children, **FELICITO** and **ORLINO**. A copy of Delfina's Death Certificate is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "K"**.
 17. However, Felicito died on 15 April 2014 without a will and heirs except **ORLINO**. A copy of the Death Certificate of Felicito is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "L"**. Likewise, a copy of his Cenomar is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "M"**.
 18. At the time of Felicito's Death, Orlino is already married to plaintiff Carmen Garro-Gerardo. A copy of their Certificate of Marriage is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "N"**. Likewise, a copy of Orlino's Cenomar is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "O"**.
 19. On 07 February 2019, Orlino died intestate and survived by the plaintiff and their children, herein plaintiffs, namely Christian and Carolyn Garro Gerardo. Copies of their Birth Certificate are attached herewith and marked as **ANNEXES "P"** and **"P-1"**. Likewise, a copy of the Certificate of Death of Orlin is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "Q"**.
 20. Prior to Orlino's death, plaintiffs visited the subject land and discovered that Defendants occupied and tilled their lot and constructed their houses thereon without their knowledge and consent.
 21. Plaintiff demanded that defendants and their family vacate the lot they had occupied/ remove the structure encroached upon/ the portion of their property but their demands remained unheeded.
 22. On 15 December 2019, Demand Letters were sent to defendants via personal service made by the Brgy. Secretary of Brgy. Curva, Pamplona, Cagayan, AILENE BACCAY, copy of which is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "R"**. However, defendants refused to receive the letter. As proof, attached herewith is the Affidavit of Aileen Baccay and marked as **ANNEX "S"**.
 23. Plaintiffs filed a complaint before the Office of Barangay airman of Curva, Pamplona, Cagayan, wherein defendants ed to attend the scheduled hearings.
 24. Defendants continue to illegally occupy the subject property. Accordingly, a "Certificate to file Action" dated 03 August 2020 was issued by the Barangay Lupon of Barangay a which is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "U"**.
 25. On 18 November 2021, another demand letter was sent the respondents thru personal service to no avail. Hence, this complaint. Copy of said demand letter is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "U"**.
 26. Plaintiffs seek to recover full possession of the subject and under the right of being the lawful owners since they are the only surviving heirs of Delfina Batara Gerardo and Jose B. Daguna.
 27. Being the lawful owners, plaintiffs are entitled to the full possession of their property and have the right to evict any person illegally occupying the same.
 28. Until now defendants refuse to vacate and are still unlawfully withholding possession/

- encroaching upon the portion of the subject property despite demands, to the damage and prejudice of the plaintiffs.
29. Accion Reivindicatoria or accion de reivindicatoria is thus an action whereby plaintiff alleges ownership over a parcel of land and seeks recovery of its full possession.
 30. In the instant case, plaintiffs, as surviving heirs, are clearly asserting their right over the land in question rooted from the ownership and title of its registered owner, Delfina Batara Gerardo.
- Second Cause of Action:*
Actual, Moral and Exemplary Damages and Attorney's Fees
31. Plaintiffs were deprived of all the beneficial use of the subject lot from the moment defendants surreptitiously entered thereto. Their possession and occupation should be charged with reasonable rental fees in the amount of TEN THOUSAND PESOS (Php10,000.00) each per month with legal interests. Otherwise, defendants would have unjustly enriched and continuously enrich themselves at the plaintiffs' expense.
 32. Plaintiffs likewise claim for any and all expenses in their repeated visits to Curva, Pamplona, Cagayan after their discovery of defendant's possession and their participation in the conciliation proceedings which were disregarded by the defendants and other costs related to this suit in the amount of FIFTY HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php50,000.00).
 33. Plaintiffs also suffered sleepless nights, mental anguish, fright, serious anxiety and wounded feelings from said dispossession. As such, defendants should be made to pay plaintiffs the amount of FIFTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php50,000.00).
 34. By way of example or correction for the public good, the defendants should likewise be made to pay the amount of ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND PESOS (Php100,000.00) as exemplary damages, to serve as deterrent to those who might unlawfully deprived a rightful owner of his/her possession.
 35. In view of the foregoing, the Plaintiff was constrained to retain the services of counsel thereby incurring expenses in the amount of EIGHTY THOUSAND PESOS (Php80,000.00) and in addition thereto, a fee of FIFTEEN THOUSAND PESOS (Php15,000.00) per court appearance, which amount should be charged against the defendants and be made payable to the plaintiff as attorney's fees, including the costs of litigation. A copy of the Contract of Legal Services is attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "V"**. Likewise, attached herewith and marked as **ANNEX "W"** and series are the copies of the receipts for the filing of the instant case.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of this Honorable Court that after due notice and hearing, judgment be rendered in favor of Plaintiffs:

1. Ordering the defendants, their family, successors, assignees, heirs and all persons claiming rights under to vacate the lot covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-2394(s) and remove the structures over the subject portion of property at the expense of defendants;
2. Ordering defendants to pay the amount of Php 10,000.00 per month with legal interests, as compensation for the reasonable use of the subject portion until they finally vacate the said premises and actual or compensatory damages in the amount of Php 100,000.00; and
3. Ordering the Defendants to pay Php50,000.00 as moral damages;
4. Ordering the Defendants to pay Php100,000.00 as exemplary damages;
5. To pay the plaintiffs the cost of the suit.

Other reliefs just and equitable under the premises are likewise prayed for.

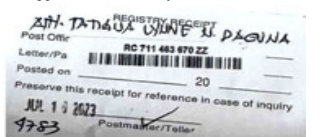
