SUMMONS BY PUBLICATION

Whereas, on February 13, 2024 a Petition was filed before this Court, which reads as follows:

1. Petitioner KALE EMMANUEL F. LAUS is of legal age, married, and a Filipino citizen. He is a resident of Brgy. 3, Alogoog, Badoc, Ilocos Norte as evidence by the hereto attach Sworn Certification of Residency, with sketch House Sketch Location, issued by the Barangay and the Government issued ID marked as **Annexes "A" and "A-1"** respectively. Further, the undersigned counsel personally verified the same as evidence by the hereto attach Affidavit marked as **Annex "C"**. He may be served with summons and court notices through the undersigned counsel.
2. Respondent AMIKA KRISTIE R. LAUS is of legal age, married, Filipino citizen, a native of Brgy. 3, Alogoog, Badoc, Ilocos Norte and is currently residing at 91-218 Maipuhi Place, Ewa Beach, Hawaii, 96706, USA, where she may be served with summons and court notices. Her active email address is Reyes.amika@yahoo.com
3. This is a petition for Declaration of Absolute Nullity of Marriage between the petitioner and respondent on the ground of psychological incapacity under **Article 36 of the Family Code**,
"A marriage contracted by any party who, at the time of the celebration, was psychologically incapacitated to comply with the essential marital obligations of marriage, shall likewise be void even if such incapacity becomes manifest only after its solemnization"
4. Petitioner is the youngest of the three children of Conrado Sr., and Lucita, both deceased. They are the second family of his father and petitioner has two older siblings. He did not grow up with his father, and only saw him at least in three instances, that is when he visited him in the hospital and during his wake. Petitioner grew up under the sole custody of his mother.
5. Respondent is the third child of Allan and Gloria. She grew up without her parents and never really knew her father. Respondent was able to meet her father only once when she was in the second grade.
6. Petitioner first saw respondent sometime in March or April of 2008. Petitioner was 18 years old and respondent was then only 13 years old. He saw respondent in the Bus Terminal in Badoc, Ilocos Norte.
7. Thereafter, petitioner was able to get the cellphone number of the respondent and started to communicate with her. They eventually got close and petitioner courted the respondent. When

- petitioner started to pursue respondent, the former has a girlfriend. In order to show his sincerity and his feelings for the respondent, he gave his cellphone to the latter, and when his Hawaii based girlfriend texted, he ended their relationship in front of the respondent. Their relationship then become official.
8. In 2009, after a year of being in a relationship, respondent went to Hawaii. However, long distance relationship is hard for them since they are both jealous types. They always quarrel over little things and also the time difference affected their relationship.
 9. One time, petitioner learned that respondent had other boyfriends, while in Hawaii. So, petitioner also looked for another girlfriend.
 10. They then broke up sometime in the year 2010 because of their romantic involvement with other persons. Shortly thereafter, respondent got pregnant by another guy at the age of 15 years old.
 11. In 2011, Petitioner was then romantically involved with the cousin of the respondent, and impregnated her.
 12. At this time, petitioner and respondent have their respective live-in partners and child.
 13. Surprisingly, in 2015, when respondent had her vacation in the Philippines, petitioner and respondent reconnected. Despite the circumstance of both having live-in partners and child, they rekindled their feelings for each other and left their respective partners and started anew their relationship.
 14. Considering that they have a child with their previous partners and that petitioner was known in the locality to be involved in drugs and a womanizer, the family of the respondent vehemently opposed their relationship, as respondent family believes that petitioner sorted to different means to survive, particularly gambling, like cock fighting, and sometimes in illegal transactions involving illegal substance.
 15. Sometime in the year 2016 petitioners' name was listed in drugs watch list.
 16. Due to this, respondent proposed that they get married in order for her to get petitioner in Hawaii. The petitioner acceded to the proposal since it was a convenient way of escaping his allege involvement in illegal drugs.
 17. Thereafter, they secretly got married on February 22, 2016 at the Office of the RTC Judge, Branch 17, Batak City, Ilocos Norte. The wedding preparation was rushed. The wedding was kept a secret from the family of their respective families due to their situation. The wedding was attended by only 10 to 12 persons with no one from the respondent's side.
 18. After their honeymoon respondent, returned to Hawaii to work for both of them and their marriage was okay for a period of at least two months.
 19. When she was in Hawaii, respondent resorted to her old ways, she would constantly go out which angered the petitioner. They only got to talk for at least 10 minutes a day and their suspicion that the other is doing something grew, and that would lead to their arguments.
 20. Petitioner would demand time from the respondent and insist that they make video calls especially when respondent is out with other

- persons. Respondent did not like the way petitioner demanded so much of her time and as a result she would ignore his calls and if they talk, they just argue.
21. Sometime in June 2016, almost four months after their wedding, respondent suddenly stopped communicating with the petitioner. Thereafter, respondent blocked him in messenger and he could no longer contact her.
 22. As the respondent stopped communicating with the petitioner, the former engaged in extra-marital affair. As a result of the infidelity of the respondent, she got pregnant by another guy sometime in December 2016. Petitioner then decided that "enough is enough".
 23. The totality of the circumstances of the case manifestly shows the blatant failure of the petitioner and respondent to comply with their marital obligations.
 24. The Psychological Report of Ms. Elizabeth Marfel F. Gagni, PhD, RPsy, PGC, Rpm, is enlightening. In her report, she stated:

"The secret wedding was an impulsive behavior and their motivations for settling down are not sound reasons for getting married. They entered marriage without knowing how serious and demanding married life can be. Their trust issues started in the onset of their relationship and during the duration of their long-distance relationship. Big portion of their relationship was spent on a long-distance mode and their trust issues, being possessive, being both jealous types and need for attention were really challenged by their long-distance set up. They were only able to live together as a married couple for several days for Amika needed to go back to Hawaii days after their wedding. They weren't able to go through the various phases of married life. They were under the honeymoon phase but they were fighting a lot. Unfortunately, they were not able to thread through their married life which was on a long distance because of Kale's abandonment issues and marked impulsivity and Amika's excessive emotionality and attention seeking tendencies. Amika found a new partner and eventually had two children aside from her first child with her live in partner before getting married"
 25. Psychological incapacity as required by Article 36 of the Family Code of the Philippines, must be characterized by (a) gravity, (b) juridical antecedence; and (c) incurability. The incapacity must be grave or serious that the party would be incapable of carrying out the ordinary duties required in marriage. It must be rooted in the history of the party antedating the marriage, although the overt manifestations may emerge only after the marriage. It must be incurable or, even if it were otherwise, the cure would be beyond the means of the party involved.
 26. After a series of tests administered from the petitioner, relatives of the petitioner and respondents, she concluded that petitioner is suffering from Borderline Personality Disorder with Antisocial Personality Disorder Traits while respondent is suffering from Histrionic Personality Disorder. Attached as **Annex "E"** is the copy of the Psychological Evaluation Report and **Annex "F"** is the copy of Curriculum Vitae of Ms. Elizabeth Marfel F. Gagni.
 27. The Borderline Personality Disorder of the petitioner stemmed from growing up without the presence and guidance of his father as well as the distress he experienced from losing his mother when he was in first

- year high school. Not having both parents during his teenage years has negatively impacted his development as a person. He was lost after the death of his mother because his mom spoiled him and she was the only person with him at that time. His many vices/impulsive activities and close attachments to friends was his way of filling the feeling of emptiness.
28. Petitioner has no direction in life for a long time. He was not interested in going to school at an early age even when prodded by his mother and as a result, he only finished first year high school. He had no motivation to find a legal way to earn money and did not aspire for bigger goals in life.
 29. Petitioner's involvement with illegal drugs and impregnating the cousin of the respondent are the reasons why the parents of the respondent were against former.
 30. The petitioner's pervasive pattern of instability of interpersonal relationship, self-image, and affects, and marked impulsivity led to the breakdown of their marriage. These are clear proofs of his failure to comply with the essential marital obligation of living together, mutual love, respect, commitment and fidelity. The petitioner's personality disorder is grave, deeply rooted in his childhood and is incurable.
 31. On the other hand, the Histrionic Personality Disorder of the respondent stemmed from her childhood getting used to having what she wants from her family and relatives especially her aunts. Accustomed to getting and doing what she wants, she has poor frustration tolerance towards the problems inherent in life and in marriage. Being the center of attention of their mother and aunts, her attention seeking behaviors as a child were reinforced. Growing up as a child in an environment where there is no lack of criticism or punishment, reinforced the development of her personality disorder. People with Histrionic Personality Disorder lack the ability to give and receive intimacy. Women with HPD are more likely to enter into an extra marital affair. The respondent manifests these two claims.
 32. The respondent's pervasive pattern of excessive emotionality and attention seeking led to the breakdown of their marriage. These are also clear proofs of failure to comply with the essential marital obligation of living together, mutual love, respect, commitment and fidelity. The respondent's personality disorder is grave, deeply rooted in her childhood and is incurable.
 33. Petitioner and respondent are living their separate lives since 2016 and despite exerting efforts especially by the Petitioner, there is no more hope for reconciliation.
 34. The property of the parties as husband and wife is governed by Absolute Community of Property regime as they did not enter into any marriage settlement before contracting marriage. However, the parties were not able to bear a child and did not obtain any properties during their marriage.
 35. The following are the documentary evidence to support the petition, to wit: 1) Sworn Certification of Residency with house location sketch; 2) Copy of the identification card of the petitioner; 3) Affidavit of the undersigned counsel; 4) Certificate of Marriage issued by the Philippine

- Statistics Authority; 5) Psychological Evaluation Report dated July 13, 2023; 6) Curriculum Vitae of Elizabeth Marfel F. Gagni and other documentary documents or object evidence that will be in the possession of the petitioner during the course of the hearing.
36. The witness to support the allegations in the petition and the summary of his testimony;
 - A. Petitioner - KALE EMMANUEL F. LAUS, to prove the material allegations in the petition.
 - B. Elizabeth Marfel F. Gagni - to explain the Psychological Evaluation Report she conducted.
 - C. Jan Robyn Reyes - to explain the nature of relationship of the petitioner and the respondent.
 - D. April Joy Bumanglag Laforteza - to explain the nature of relationship of the petitioner and the respondent.
 37. The petition was not filed to harass, cause unnecessary delay, or needlessly increase the cost of litigation, and;
 38. The factual allegations therein have evidentiary support or, if specifically identified, will likewise have evidentiary support after a reasonable opportunity for discovery.
- WHEREFORE**, it is most respectfully prayed to this Honorable Court that, after due notice and proceedings, render judgment as follows:
1. Declaring the marriage entered into by the parties as **NULL AND VOID**; and
 2. Ordering the Local Civil Registrar of Batak City, Ilocos Norte and Philippine Statistics Authority to cancel from their respective Book of Marriages the entry covering the marriage between the parties and to record the judgment declaring the absolute nullity of the marriage between said parties.
- Other reliefs and remedies deemed just and equitable under the premises are likewise prayed for.
