SUMMONS

On 27 September 2022 Sanima J. Arakama, Petitioner, through her counsel, Atty. Regie C. Bangayan, filed a Petition for the Surrender of Withheld Owner's Duplicate Copy of Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. T-48,400 of the Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City, alleging, among others, the following:

"PETITION

Petitioner SANIMA J. ARAKAMA, through her undersigned counsel and unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully files this Petition and alleges that:

PARTIES

1. Petitioner SANIMA J. ARAKAMA (PETITIONER, for brevity) is of legal age, Filipino citizen, married, with residence and postal address at Padua Drive, Sta. Maria, Zamboanga City where she may be served with summons and other court processes by the Honorable Court.

2. Respondent JULIETA L. NATIVIDAD - MANALANG (RESPONDENT, for brevity), is also of legal age, Filipino citizen, and with last known address at Bk. 6 L11, Barangay San Simon, Dasmariñas, Cavite where she may be served with court summons and other court processes.

ANTECEDENT FACTS

3. The lot covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-48,400 of the Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City, title subject of this case, is still registered in the name of the late mother of RESPONDENT, Ignacia L. Natividad. The parcel of land is more particularly described as follows:

Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-48,400 Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City
A parcel of land (Lot 7-B of the subdivision plan Psd-09001197, being a portion of Lot 7, (LRC) Pcs-5668, situated in the Barrio of Tetuan. City of Zamboanga, containing an area of Six Hundred Ninety (690) Square Meters, registered under the name of Ignacia L. Natividad, Filipino, widow.

The electronic copy of Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-48,400 is herein attached as Annex "A".
The fair market value of the said real property is Php 427,800.00 and the Assessed Value is Php 85,560.00 as shown by the copy of the latest Tax Declaration of Real Property with TD No. 1101008502160 issued by the Office of the City Assessor of Zamboanga City, a copy is hereto attached as Annex "E".

4. On 06 July 2001, RESPONDENT and Lourdes Natividad (LOURDES, for brevity), executed a Deed of Exchange wherein the latter waived all her rights and interest on a parcel of land known as Lot 2-D, located at Sta. Maria, Zamboanga City and covered by Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-113,866, in exchange for the rights and interests of RESPONDENT over the subject lot (Lot No. 7-B) located in Tetuan, Zamboanga City.

A copy of the Deed of Exchange dated 06 July 2001 is hereto attached as Annex "B".

5. On 17 April 2002, RESPONDENT and Lourdes executed an Addendum to Deed of Exchange, herein the both parties agreed and request that their Deed of Exchange be registered before the Registry of Deeds for Zamboanga City.

A copy of the Addendum to Deed of Exchange dated 17 April 2002 is hereto attached as Annex "C".

6. On 19 November 2014, RESPONDENT executed the Deed of Absolute Sale in favor of PETITIONER duly notarized by Notary Public, Atty. Manuel Wee Sit IV, under Document Number 108; Page No. 22; Book No. VIII and Series of 2014, involving the subject parcel of land and title which was adjudicated in favor of RESPONDENT pursuant to said Deed of Exchange and Addendum of Deed of Exchange. A copy of said Deed of Absolute Sale is hereto attached as Annex "D".

7. Notwithstanding the sale of the subject lot to PETITIONER, RESPONDENT did not turn over the Owner's Duplicate Copy of TCT No. T-48,400 to former despite repeated requests to surrender or turn over the subject owner's duplicate of title.

8. Subsequently, and because of Petitioner insistence and persistent follow-up, RESPONDENT finally admitted that she misplaced the title, and that she would execute and deliver to PETITIONER an Affidavit of Loss of the said title to support the filing of a Petition for the Issuance of New Owner's Duplicate in lieu of the Lost One before the court. However, RESPONDENT left for Manila without any case for issuance of lost title being filed in court until at present or even and execution of an affidavit of loss.

9. In order to protect her rights and interests, PETITIONER filed an Affidavit of Adverse Claim dated 09 October 2018 before the Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City and duly annotated on subject title under Entry No. 2018007158. A copy of the Affidavit of Loss dated 13 October 2018 is hereby attached as Annex "F".

10. Also, PETITIONER sought legal advice from her previous counsel, thus, on 15 November 2018, she filed an Affidavit of Loss dated 13 November 2018 of the subject title before the Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City and it was annotated thereon as Entry No. 2018008020. A copy of the Affidavit of Loss dated 13 November 2018 is hereby attached as Annex "G".

11. On 21 March 2019, PETITIONER, through her previous counsel, filed a Petition for Surrender of Owner's Duplicate of the subject title before Regional Trial Court, Branch 34, Zamboanga City docketed as Civil Case No. 7069. Consequently, it was DISMISSED WITHOUT PREJUDICE for non-compliance with Section 6, Rule 7 of Rules of Court, per Order dated 10 August 2020.

A copy of the Order dated 10 August 2022 is hereto attached as Annex "H".

12. On 22 August 2022, after ascertaining the last known address of RESPONDENT, PETITIONER sent her a Final Demand and/or Request Letter through registered mail and LBC Express requesting RESPONDENT to surrender the Owner's Duplicate Copy of Transfer Certificate of Title No. T-48,400.

A copy of the Final Demand and/or Request Letter dated 22 August 2022 is hereto attached as Annex "I", the LBC Express, Inc. OR No. VTR049630 is attached as Annex "J" and the Registry Mail Receipt No. RC 477 674 298 ZZ is attached as Annex "J-1".

13. Until now, PETITIONER is not able to recover or take possession of the said owner's duplicate copy as RESPONDENT did not appear before the Register of Deeds, the court or before her after registration of the Affidavit of Loss to prove that the same was indeed lost or not lost, whichever may be. Further, PETITIONER has not heard from RESPONDENT until now.

14. PETITIONER has also processed and settled the Capital Gains Tax and Documentary Tax for the Deed of Absolute Sale executed in her favour by RESPONDENT with the Bureau of Internal Revenue, Zamboanga City. In addition, on year 2019, PETITIONER has paid the real property tax due on the subject land per official receipt issued by the City Treasurer of Zamboanga City dated 27 February 2019 as shown by the Certificate Authorizing Registration issued by the BIR, Zamboanga City and the official receipts representing the real property tax due for year 2019 and 2022 are hereto attached as Annexes "K" and "L to L-1," respectively.

CAUSE OF ACTION:

AS BUYER, PETITIONER IS ENTITLED TO THE POSSESSION OF THE OWNER'S DUPLICATE COPY OF TCT NO. T-48,400

Incorporating and adopting the assertions found in the preceding paragraphs, Petitioner further alleges -

15. However, since the owner's duplicate copy of the subject title is not in the possession of the PETITIONER, she could not register with the Office of the Registry of Deeds of Zamboanga City the said deed of absolute sale unless and until owner's duplicate copy thereof which is in the possession of the RESPONDENT

be surrendered first to the Office of the Registry of Deeds. Thus, there is need to compel RESPONDENT to surrender the said owner's duplicate pursuant to Section 107 of the Property Registration Decree or P.D. 1529 which provides that:

SECTION 107. Surrender of withheld duplicate certificates. - Where it is necessary to issue a new certificate of title pursuant to any involuntary instrument which divests the title of the registered owner against his consent or where a voluntary instrument cannot be registered by reason of the refusal or failure of the holder to surrender the owner's duplicate certificate of title, the party in interest may file a petition in court to compel surrender of the same to the Register of Deeds. The court, after hearing, may order the registered owner or any person withholding the certificate to surrender the same, and direct the entry of a new certificate or memorandum upon such surrender. If the person withholding the duplicate certificate is not amenable to the process of the court, or if not any reason the outstanding owner's duplicate certificate cannot be delivered, the court may order the annulment of the same as well as the issuance of a new certificate of title in lieu thereof. Such new certificate and all duplicates thereof shall contain a memorandum of the annulment of the outstanding duplicate.

16. Despite the sale, PETITIONER is unable to fully enjoy her rights and interests over the parcel subject of the case because of the RESPONDENT's inaction and failure to surrender the title despite several oral and written demands for a span of more than four (4) years.

WITNESSES TO BE PRESENTED:

17. In support of the foregoing allegations in the instant Petition, the testimony of the following witness is being offered-

a. SANIMA J. ARAKAMA - to support the allegations found in the Petitioner; to testify that she is the buyer and owner of the parcel of land (Lot 7-B) covered by TCT No. 48, 400 of the Registry of Deeds for Zamboanga City; to identify the petition, her judicial affidavits and the annexes referred thereto; and to testify as to other matters related and germane to her main testimony.

PRAYER

WHEREFORE, PREMISES CONSIDERED, it is respectfully prayed of this Honorable Court, that after due notice and hearing, an Order be issued, as follows:

- 1. Ordering Respondent to surrender the Owner's Duplicate Copy of TCT No. T-48,400 of the Register of Deeds of Zamboanga City, which is in their custody and/or possession;
2. If Respondent refuses to surrender the same, or if for any reason the outstanding owner's duplicate certificate cannot be delivered, the Honorable Court shall order the annulment or cancellation of the same and the issuance of new certificate of title pursuant to Section 75 of P.D. 1529;
3. Directing the Register of Deeds of Zamboanga City, to cancel TCT No. T-48,400 sans the owner's duplicate of title and issue a new one in favor of the petitioners, upon payment of all the proper fees therefor; and
4. Petitioner prays for such other reliefs as may be just and equitable in the premises.
