**Section 6.** Designation of Courts and Promulgation of Procedural Rules - The Supreme Court shall designate the Court or Courts that will hear and resolve cases brought under this Act and shall promulgate the rules of pleading, practice and procedure to govern the proceedings brought this act.

Petitioner likewise submitted his judicial Affidavit executed on May 8, 2024. Petitioner alleged that he is the Treasurer/COO of DRCPI and holds 34.95% shares therein. Said corporation suffered business losses due to the COVID-19 pandemic and was constrained to resort to massive borrowing of money in order to sustain its business operations. He infused sums of money in cash to DRCPI raise funds for the corporation. He likewise restructured his remaining personal loans from credit cards and turned over the proceeds to DRCPI, which eventually backfired because he ended up with a higher amount of debt. Eventually, DRCPI ceased business operations on November 30, 2023 and filed a Petition for Liquidation before the RTC of Dasmariñas City, Cavite.

After a close review and perusal of the Petition and the documents submitted by the petitioner, the Court, in the exercise of its discretion, is convinced and hereby finds that petitioner is indeed insolvent. As pointed out by the petitioner, while his assets in the amount of PHP 16,528,345.43 are partly higher than his liabilities in the amount of PHP 14,928,965.59, the bulk of his assets are receivables from DRCPI which also has a pending petition for liquidation. Undoubtedly, petitioner's financial condition shows as he duly asserted that it cannot anymore service the payment of his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business-thus, insolvent.

WHEREFORE, premises considered, the instant Petition is hereby GRANTED. The Court hereby DECLARES petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES to be INSOLVENT. Accordingly, the Court hereby Declares, Pronounces and Rules on the following, to wit:

1. The Court ORDERS the liquidation of RONILO T. QUIÑONES who is hereby DECLARED as INSOLVENT.
2. The Court's Branch Sheriff, Carlito M. Salandanan, is hereby ORDERED to take possession and control of all the properties of petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES, except those that may be exempt from execution;
3. The petitioner is ORDERED to PUBLISH within 15 days from receipt hereof the instant Liquidation Order with a copy of his verified Petition in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines once a week for two (2) consecutive weeks;
4. All the debtors of petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES are DIRECTED to make payments of any and all claims and conveyance of any property due the petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES to the Liquidator-after the Liquidator shall have been appointed;
5. From the issuance of this Liquidation Order, petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES is PROHIBITED from making any payments and transfer any of his properties;
6. All creditors are DIRECTED to FILE their respective claims with the Liquidator not later than five (5) days from the time the Liquidator takes his oath of office--after he or she shall have been appointed--and furnishing a copy thereof to the Court;
7. Petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES is hereby AUTHORIZED to PAY the Administrative Expenses as they become due:
  - (h) The creditors who are not petitioners of the instant Petition may submit the names of other nominees to the position of the Liquidator; and
  - (i) The instant Petition shall be set for hearing for the election and appointment of the Liquidator thirty (30) days after the second and last publication of this Liquidation Order with the verified Petition.

Send a copy of this Order to Atty. Inocencio R. Vivero, Jr., and the petitioner. They are hereby directed to furnish a copy of this Order to all his creditors and to submit compliance within ten (10) days from receipt of this Order.

PETITION FOR LIQUIDATION

Petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES, by and through the undersigned Counsel, and

unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully states that:

NATURE OF THE PETITION

1.0 The instant case is one for Petition for Liquidation being filed pursuant to Republic Act" (R.A.) No. 10142, otherwise known as the "Financial Rehabilitation and Insolvency Act of 2010 (FRIA) and also under A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC or the Financial Liquidation and Suspension of Payments Rules of Procedure for Insolvent Debtors (2015) promulgated by the Supreme Court on 21 April 2015.

2.0 It is the position of herein petitioner that under his present state, it is experiencing financial incapacity to pay his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business.

3.0 Thus, this petition seeks for this Honorable Court to issue a Liquidation Order in accordance with Rule 4, paragraph (a), of the aforesaid A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC.

STATEMENT OF MATERIAL FACTS

4.0 Petitioner RONILO T. QUIÑONES ("QUIÑONES" for brevity) is a Filipino, married, and a resident of Block 11, Lot 19, Aspen Drive, Southview Homes 1, Pacita 2, San Pedro City, Laguna, Philippines.

5.0 Copies of the Philippine Long Distance Telephone (PLDT) Statement of Account from November 2023 up to April 2024 and the Unified Multi-Purpose ID (UMID) card of petitioner QUIÑONES are herewith attached and marked as ANNEXES "A" and series of this Petition as proof of residence of herein petitioner QUIÑONES.

6.0 Petitioner QUIÑONES is the Treasurer/Chief Operation Officer (COO) of Dynamic Resource Commercial Products Inc. ("DRCPI").

7.0 DRCPI is a corporation duly formed, organized, and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines as evidenced by its Certificate of Incorporation with Company Reg. No. CS201314689 dated 29 July 2013 issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) herewith attached and marked as ANNEX "B" of this Petition.

8.0 Then, on 08 December 2015, DRCPI amended its Articles of Incorporation before the SEC as shown in its Certificate of Filing of Amended Articles of Incorporation herewith attached and marked as ANNEX "B-1" of this Petition.

9.0 Petitioner QUIÑONES holds 34.95% shares in DRCPI.

10.0 DRCPI is engaged in the business of trading, marketing, distribution of, but not limited to, locally manufactured and imported machinery equipment, products and parts

11.0 Its principal place of business is at Unit 25-27, Century Commercial Complex, Brgy. Salawag, Paliparan, Molino Road, Dasmariñas City, Province of Cavite, Philippines.

12.0 The business operations of DRCPI went on smoothly from the time it started its business in the year 2013 up to the last part of the year 2019.

13.0 However, in the year 2020, when the dreaded coronavirus disease (COVID-19) became a global health issue that had affected billions of lives and numerous businesses around the world, including the Philippines, the business operations, particularly its profitability, of DRCPI started to dwindle.

14.0 In the said year, due to several economic lockdowns, DRCPI was constrained to resort to massive borrowing of money in order to sustain its business operation. The company was doing this practice of obtaining loans even before the pandemic but the volume of borrowings started to increase during the pandemic season. The company borrowed money from lending institutions, banks-including credit lines from petitioner QUIÑONES personal credit cards. At that time, the company was still able to handle its finances - albeit the borrowings-as sales during that period were still alright and could still cover whatever interest expense DRCPI accumulated.

15.0 During the year 2020, DRCPI only operated for a period of ten (10) months due to the strict implementation of "community quarantine and COVID-19 health protocols within the Philippines. As a result, the company registered only a small positive figure at the end of its Audited Financial Statement (AFS) for the year

16.0 In the year 2021, the market started to slow down. At this point, the after effect of the COVID-19 restrictions and other contributing factors, such as the implementation of the Rice Tariffication Law and the parallel importation of various agricultural products, greatly affected the income of the farmers and fishermen thereby limiting their purchasing power. Resultantly, the whole agricultural sector business suffered-including that of DRCPI's business. However, DRCPI continued with its business operations while securing loans from institutions, banks and credit cards.

17.0 In the year 2022, DRCPI tried to bridge its financing gaps by borrowing money left and right from banks and various lending institutions. Most of the time, at high interest rates. The company decided to enter into these kinds of loan as it was hoping that the market will recover and everything will go back to normal. Unfortunately, it did not. The company's market started to decline and the situation brought the company to heavy debts. The company still ordered containers full of agricultural products so that it could continue to sell and compete. However, it did not foresee the lockdown in China from June-October. This resulted to delays in the arrivals of its orders.

18.0 The delays in arrival lasted for six (6) months. In the middle of it all, DRCPI borrowed money left and right from banks, financial institutions and cash loans using petitioner QUIÑONES personal credit cards ("Cash to Go", "Credit to Cash", etc.). Petitioner QUIÑONES even entered into personal loans from Security Bank just to sustain DRCPI's day-to-day operations.

19.0 By the end of 2022, DRCPI had a big negative deficit. However, it opted not to stop the operations.

20.0 In the year 2023, due to this financial setback, DRCPI considered applying for insolvency. However, its Board of Directors decided to continue its business operation with the hope that it will be able to recover from its economic losses.

21.0 Since DRCPI is only the source of income of petitioner QUIÑONES and the business also has performed well enough up to 2020, he decided to sell his personal properties including house and lot and shares of stocks so as to be able to raise funds.

22.0 With this, petitioner QUIÑONES was able to infuse another PHILIPPINE PESOS: SEVEN MILLION (Php7,000,000.00) in cash to DRCPI during the first quarter. DRCPI also again borrowed money from private individuals and small lending companies who still offered some short-term loans to support DRCPI's operations.

23.0 In addition, petitioner QUIÑONES re-structured his remaining personal loans from credit cards. This is for the loans he entered into and turned-over to DRCPI for additional funds. This move, however, eventually backfired. Because of the restructuring petitioner QUIÑONES eventually ended up with higher amount of debt. Obviously, the reason for the loan restructuring is because-at that time he thought that it was the best calculated-risk to take. Again, these were all done in the hope that the market will recover and everything will return to normal.

24.0 With all these situation on-hand making orders for new containers, prioritizing the settling of the finance charges and initial interests on the loan restructuring agreements the company entered into DRCPI was not able to sustain the operations as it initially thought it could

25.0 As it happened, DRCPI ceased its business operation last 30 November 2023. 26.0 Consequently, on 05 January 2024, DRCPI filed a Petition for Liquidation before the Regional Trial Court of Dasmariñas City, Cavite which was docketed as CRC No. 00002-24 and was raffled to Branch 128 thereat. A copy of said Petition for Liquidation of DRCPI dated 05 January 2024 is herewith attached and marked as ANNEX "C" of this Petition.

27.0 DRCPI instituted the aforesaid Petition for Liquidation as it is experiencing financial incapacity to pay its liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business and that its liabilities are greater than its assets. In support hereof, attached herewith is the latest Audited Financial Statement of DRCPI and marked as ANNEX "C-1" of this Petition.

28.0 With the present depleted financial condition of DROP petitioner QUIÑONES is now in a situation where he does not anymore have the capacity to pay all of his debtors-banks, institutions, private individuals and credit cards. As it stands, the remaining assets of petitioner QUIÑONES is in the amount of PHILIPPINE PESOS: SIXTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED FORTY FIVE and 43/100 (Php16,528,345.43), on the other hand, his total listin in the amount of PHILIPPINE PESOS: FOURTEEN MILLION NINE HUNDRED TWENTY EIGHT THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED SIXTY FIVE and 59/100 (Php14,928,965.59)

29.0 Noteworthy, while the assets of petitioner QUIÑONES partly higher than his liabilities, it should be pointed out that the bulk of his assets, particularly the credit card and personal loans and the advances made to DRCPI in the combined total amount of PHILIPPINE PESOS: SIXTEEN MILLION FIVE HUNDRED TWENTY TWO THOUSAND SEVEN HUNDRED EIGHTY EIGHT and 44/100 (Php16,522,788.44), was

invested in DRCPI which unfortunately happens to be in the state of insolvency as of the moment. Such being the case, the financial liquidity of herein petitioner QUIÑONES hangs in the balance and would really not be able to satisfy his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business.

30.0 Petitioner QUIÑONES is willing to comply with all the conditions/requirements which the Honorable Court may impose relative to the foregoing Petition.

31.0 In support of this Petition, petitioner QUIÑONES will testify to bolster his claim.

32.0 Petitioner QUIÑONES shall also present the following documentary evidence in support of his petition:

- 32.1 PLDT Statement of Account November 2023 up to April 2024 and the UMID card of petitioner QUIÑONES (ANNEX "A" and series of this Petition);
- 32.2 Certificate of Incorporation with Company Reg No. CS201314689 dated 29 July 2013 of DRCPI issued by the SEC (ANNEX "B" of this Petition);
