ORDINANCE NO. 1208, Series of 2024 AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING A NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME COVERING THE STREETS OF G. MOLINA and ITC OF BARANGAY CANUMAY EAST, VALENZUELA CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES THEREOF.

SECTION 1. TITLE. This ordinance shall be known as the "An ordinance providing a new traffic scheme in Barangay Canumay East, Valenzuela City, providing penalties thereof and for other purposes".

SECTION 2. COVERAGE. All motorists, residents and non-residents traversing through the streets and/or roads of Canumay East, Valenzuela City are required to obey the new traffic scheme.

SECTION 3. THE NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME. A new Traffic Scheme in Canumay East, Valenzuela City is as follows:

a. Wide Bodied Vehicles weighing more than 4500 kg, Vehicles with a height of three (3) meters, trucks, buses and alike shall not be allowed to pass through an unnamed street locally referred to as G. Molina Street (Interior) connecting G. Molina St., and ITC covering an area of 231 meters, more or less.

b. Affected Vehicles coming from G. Molina to ITC road may take Gen. Luis Street.

c. Affected Vehicles coming from ITC to Molina may take D. Bonifacio Street.

d. A period of 45 days upon the effectivity of this Ordinance shall serve as a dry-run to familiarize the motorists, commuting public and pedestrian.

SECTION 4. EXEMPTIONS. This Ordinance shall not apply to:

a. Law enforcement vehicles and emergency vehicles;

b. Official City/Barangay vehicles;

c. Private vehicles, when performing urgent tasks or necessity for reasons of health, physical disability or unique hardship only for the period necessary to accomplish their tasks or special purpose.

SECTION 5. IMPOSITION OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES. Any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the offender driver/operator/owner with the following administrative penalties, to wit:

1st Offense - **P1,000.00**

2nd Offense - **P3,000.00**

3rd Offense & subsequent violations - **P5,000.00**

Payments of said Administrative Penalty shall be made to the City Treasurer's Office upon presentation of the Ordinance Violation Receipt (OVR) accordingly issued to the owner/driver by the authorized or deputized City Government personnel or authorized or deputized Barangay personnel.

SECTION 6. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITIES and ISSUANCE OF IMPLEMENTING RULES and REGULATIONS

a. Traffic Management Office (TMO);

b. Task Force Disiplina

Implementation shall be on 24/7 basis unless there is a need to suspend particular areas only for reasons of emergencies like fire, calamities, disasters and fiesta or special occasions.

The Barangay shall assist in the implementation of this ordinance, such as but not limited to conduct of massive information campaign and to provide traffic assistance from Barangay Tanod or Barangay staff.

In the Order dated June 13, 2024, this Court granted that the Summons issue to be effected upon respondent Jemel M. Suello by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines once a week for TWO (2) consecutive weeks, pursuant to Sec. 6(b) of the Rule on Declaration of Absolute Nullity of Marriage in relation Rule 14 of the Rules of Court, at the expense of the petitioner.

NOW THEREFORE, you are hereby required within THIRTY (30) DAYS after the last publication of this summons, to file with this Court and serve on the Petitioner your Answer to the Petition with the following principal grounds and reliefs prayed to wit:

IV. CAUSE OF ACTION Declaration of Nullity of Marriage Based on Article 36 of the Family Code

Article 36 of the Family Code states of Psychological Incapacity as ground for Nullity of Marriage, thus:

"Art. 36. A marriage contracted by any party who, at the time of the celebration, was psychologically incapacitated to comply with the essential marital obligations of marriage, shall likewise be void even if such incapacity becomes manifest only after its solemnization."

Article 36 of the Family Code as provided in the case of NOEL P. BACCAY versus MARIBEL C. BACCAY and REPUBLIC OF THE PHILIPPINES, the High Courts stated that:

"Dissecting the terms of the provision, we list down its elements:

- 1. a celebration of marriage; 2. non-performance of marital obligations; 3. the marital obligations which are not performed are essential marital obligations; 4. non-performance is due to cause psychological in nature and it is chronic; constant and habitual 5. the cause/s are present during the celebration of marriage although they may not be manifested or evident at that point; and 6. the cause/s surface after the celebration of marriage."

Psychological incapacity relate to the essential obligations of marriage, i.e., "it is the non-performance of this class of obligations which lead to a declaration of nullity of marriage due to psychological incapacity." Corollarily, "the non-compliance with these non-essential marital obligations has no effect on the validity of the marriage."

As found by Dr. Jose G. Del Rosario, a qualified clinical psychologist, respondent manifested a clear basic underlying psychodynamic in capacities as shown in his Character Traits Deficits known as Antisocial Disorder, Disorder of Impulse Control and Narcissistic Character which is incurable, serious and grave in his person-individual. (DSM-IV-TR-TM 2000: General Diagnostic Criteria for Personality Disorder). The psychological report indicates that:

"The Antisocial Disorder, Disorder of Impulse Control and Narcissistic Character for the respondent have existed since his adolescent period of life, thus, the condition were present even before his marriage ceremony and even thereafter giving way to a more exaggerated expression of dysfunctional personality which were already existing before the celebration of his marriage but were strongly manifested during and after the solemnization of their marriage, thus his personality and character trait deficit or stage of psychological incapacity are dysfunctional and harmful to marriage routines and appear to be incurable and permanent. This is so because personality and

character traits are permanent, enduring, and pervasive patterns of responding to the world, in thoughts, feelings and in actions. It is resistant and/or unresponsive to Psychiatric management and/or treatment approaches of all methods because it is already the patterns of personality and character deficits inborn in his very person-individual. After a thorough, diligent and careful Psychiatric and Psychological evaluation on this particular marriage (Concernman-Suello) now in total, complete wreck, the undersigned Neuro-Psychiatry/ Screener and the herein Psychologist has finally drawn a firm and honest opinion that the respondent has indeed for a fact exhibited and manifested a clear clinical picture or an impression of person-individual who is actually suffering a very serious and grave degree of psychological incapacities or mental maladies and character deficits which completely and totally incapacities him in complying with his marital obligations towards the petitioner due to the presence of a personality and Character Trait Deficits of respondent known as Antisocial Disorder of Impulse Control and Narcissistic Character, which is serious and grave enough to unable him to give meaning and significance to their marriage and carry out the day-to-day obligations in marriage. Respondent here is dysfunctional or impaired to perform his role as husband because he has existing personality disorders known as Antisocial Disorder, Disorder of Impulse Control and Narcissistic Character that disrupted or hampered him to perceive the importance and value their life together. His personality disorders have already permanently blocked him from responding appropriately to what is marital obligations. His personality disorders are resistant to therapy because it is incurable; that he himself would never recognize this as a dysfunction to them. He continued to live a life selfishly and arrogantly of who he is and what he is doing, even if it meant hurting them both and destroying their marriage. Antisocial Disorder, Disorder of Impulse Control and Narcissistic Character may seem normal or natural to some people like Mr. Jemel M. Suello but actually it is very serious and grave personality aberration that already caused many lives so much distress. He always makes their relationship as a source of gratification, for him to feel good, seek pleasure and answer to his selfish needs. He has grown a true-blue dysfunctional person with his personality disorder and he shall remain impaired that way. The absence of trust, respect, faith, and love makes it harder for their marriage to stand.

RECOMMENDATION: IT IS THEREFORE MY HUMBLE AND HONEST OPINION THAT RESPONDENT, JEMEL M. SUELLO IS SUFFERING FROM PSYCHOLOGICAL INCAPACITIES KNOWN AS ANTISOCIAL DISORDER, DISORDER OF IMPULSE CONTROL AND NARCISSISTIC CHARACTER, WHICH IS SO GRAVE, INCURABLE AND PERMANENT. AS SUCH, IT IS MOST HUMBLE AND RESPECTFULLY RECOMMENDED THAT THE PETITION FOR "DECLARATION OF NULLITY OF MARRIAGE" OF PETITIONER BE GRANTED BY THIS HONORABLE COURT FOR THE BETTERMENT OF BOTH PARTIES AND THEIR TWO (2) CHILDREN." xxx

IV. PRAYER WHEREFORE, premises considered, it is most respectfully prayed of this Honorable Court that a judgment be rendered as follows:

- 1. Declaring the marriage of herein parties celebrated on 08 June 2019 as NULL AND VOID; 2. Directing the Local Civil Registrar of Getafe, Bohol and the Head of the Philippine Statistic Authority to record said judgment in the parties' marriage records and/or in the appropriate marriage registers.

Other, just and equitable remedies and reliefs are likewise prayed for." You are reminded of the provision in the IBP-OCA Memorandum on Policy Guidelines dated March 12, 2002 to observe restraint in filing a motion to dismiss and instead allege the grounds thereof as defenses in the Answer. If you fail to answer within the time fixed or if your answer does not render an issue, the Court shall order the public prosecutor to investigate whether collusion exists between the Petitioner and Respondent.
