ORDER

Before this Court is a Petition for the Issuance of a Replacement of Lost Owner's Copy of Transfer Certificate of Title (TCT) No. PT-89552, filed by Victor G. Kho and Ernesto G. Kho (petitioners), represented by their Attorney-in-Fact, Francisco G. Chingcuangco (Chingcuangco), on July 9, 2024.

Petitioners allege that they are the registered owners of the parcel of land situated at Barangay Malinao, Pasig City, covered by TCT No. PT-89522 of the Registry of Deeds for Pasig City. Sometime on April 24, 2023, they executed a Special Power of Attorney to Chingcuangco authorizing him to transact and negotiate with the Local Government of Pasig City for the payment for the use of the property as a road lot. They entrusted the subject owner's duplicate copy of TCT No. PT-89552, with several other papers and documents to Chingcuangco, who kept the same in folders with other important documents in a shelf in his residence.

Sometime on April 2024, petitioners requested Chingcuangco for updates regarding the aforementioned payment of the local government for the use of the subject property as a road lot. Immediately Chingcuangco contacted the Pasig City Officials he initially talked to about the

matter. They required him to show the original owner's copy of TCT No. PT-89522. However, Chingcuangco failed to locate the subject title on the shelf where he kept it for a year. Earnest effort to locate the same where in vain. Chingcuangco finally considered the subject title as lost. Thus, he executed an Affidavit of Loss which he caused to be registered with the Registry of Deeds of Pasig City, and annotated under Entry No. 20240061726 in the Memorandum of Encumbrances of the subject TCT.

Petitioners also allege that the original owner's copy of the subject TCT was never recalled, cancelled, or revoked by the issuing government office or agency, nor conveyed and transferred to other person or persons. They further claim that the original owner's copy of the subject TCT was neither pledged, mortgaged nor given as security or collateral. Hence, this Petition, praying that, "Xxxx the Honorable Court to grant this Petition to declare as lost the original owner's copy of Transfer Certificate of Title No. PT-89522 and thereafter, to order respondent Register of Deeds of Pasig City to Issue a replacement."

WHEREFORE, notice is hereby given that the instant Petition will be heard by the court, sitting at 6th Floor, Hall of Justice, City Hall Complex, Carruncho Avenue, Pasig City, on **October 23, 2024 at 8:30 in the morning**, at which place, date and time, all interested persons are hereby cited to appear and show cause, if they have any, why the Petition should not be granted.

PETITION FOR LIQUIDATION

Petitioner **CHARMAIGNE D. COLE**, by and through the undersigned Counsel, and unto this Honorable Court, most respectfully states - that:

NATURE OF THE PETITION

1.0 The instant case is one for Petition for Liquidation being filed pursuant to Republic Act (RA.) No. 10142, otherwise known as the "Financial Rehabilitation and Insolvency Act" of 2010 (FRIA) and also under A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC or the Financial Liquidation and Suspension of Payments Rules of Procedure for Insolvent Debtors (2015) promulgated by the Supreme Court on 21 April 2015.

2.0 It is the position of herein petitioner that under his present state, it is experiencing financial incapacity to pay his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business and that his liabilities are greater than his assets.

3.0 Thus, this petition seeks for this Honorable Court to issue a Liquidation Order in accordance with Rule 4, paragraph (a), of the aforesaid A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC.

STATEMENT OF MATERIAL FACTS

4.0 Petitioner **CHARMAIGNE D. COLE** (COLE for brevity) is a Filipino, married, and a resident of Block 81, Lot 20, Phase 4, Bel Air, Don Jose, Sta. Rosa City, Laguna, Philippines.

5.0 Copies of the MERALCO Electric Bill from June 2023 to November 2023 and the go Copies of the Government issued identification (ID) cards of petitioner COLE are herewith attached and marked as ANNEXES "A" and series of this Petition as proof of residence of herein petitioner COLE.

6.0 Petitioner COLE is the President/Chief Executive Officer (CEO) of Dynamic Resources Commercial Products Inc. ("DRCPI")

7.0 DRCPI is a corporation duly forzaed, organized, and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines as evidenced by its Certificate of Incorporation with Company Reg. No. CS201314689 dated 29 July 2013 issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) herewith attached and marked as ANNEX 8" of this Petition.

8.0 Then, on 08 December 2015, DRCPI amended its Articles of Incorporation before the SEC as shown in its Certificate of Filing of Amended Articles of Incorporation herewith attached and marked as ANNEX "B-1" of this Petition.

9.0 DRCPI Petitioner COLE holds forty percent (40%) shares in DRCPI.

10.0 DRCPI is engaged in the business of trading, marketing, distribution of, but not limited to, locally manufactured and imported machinery equipment, products and parts.

11.0 Its principal place of business is at Unit 25-27, Century Commercial Complex, Brgy. Salawag, Paliparan, Molino Road, Dasmariñas City, Province of Cavite, Philippines.

12.0 The business operations of went on smoothly from the time it started its business in the year 2013 up to the last part of the year 2019.

13.0 However, in the year 2020, when the dreaded coronavirus disease (COVID-19) became a global health issue that had

affected billions of lives and numerous businesses around the world, including the Philippines, the business operations, particularly its profitability, of DRCPI started to dwindle.

14.0 In the said year, due to several economic lockdowns, DRCPI was constrained to resort to massive borrowing of money in order to sustain its business operation. The company was doing this practice of obtaining loans even before the pandemic but the volume of borrowings started to increase during the pandemic season. The company borrowed money from lending institutions, banks-including credit lines from petitioner COLE's personal credit cards. At that time, the company was still able to handle its finances - albeit the borrowings - as sales during that period were still alright and could still cover what ever interest expense DRCPI accumulated.

15.0 During the year 2020, DRCPI operated for a period of ten (10) months due to the strict implementation of "community quarantine and COVID-19 health protocols within the Philippines. As a result, the company registered only a small positive figure at the end of its Audited Financial Statement (AFS) for the year.

16.0 In the year 2021, the market started to slow down. At this point, the after-effect of the COVID-19 restrictions and other contributing factors, such as the implementation of the Rice Tariffication Law and the parallel importation of various agricultural products, greatly affected the income of the farmers and fishermen thereby limiting their purchasing power. Resultantly, the whole agricultural sector business suffered - including that of petitioner DRCPI's business. However, DRCPI continued with its business operations while securing loans from institutions, banks and credit cards.

17.0 In the year 2022, DRCPI tried to bridge its financing gaps by borrowing money left and right from banks and various lending institutions. Most of the time, at high interest rates. The company decided to enter into these kinds of loan as it was hoping that the market wul recover and everything will go back to normal. Unfortunately, it did not. The company's market started to decline and the situation brought the company to heavy debts. The company still ordered containers full of agricultural products so that it could continue to sell and compete. However, it did not foresee the lockdown in China from June-October. This resulted to delays in the arrivals of its orders.

18.0 The delays in arrival lasted for six (6) months. In the middle of it all, DRCPI borrowed money left and right from banks, financial institutions and cash loans using petitioner COLE's personal credit cards ("Cash to Go", "Credit to Cash", etc.). Petitioner COLE even entered into personal loans from banks (namely: Eastwest, Equicom, Security Bank and BPI) just to sustain DRCPI's day-to-day operations.

19.0 By the end of 2022, DRCPI had a big negative deficit. However, it opted not to stop the operations.

20.0 In the year 2023, due to this financial setback, DRCPI considered applying for insolvency. However, its Board of Directors decided to continued for usiness operation with the hope that it will be able to recover from its economic losses.

21.0 Since DRCPI is the only source of income of petitioner COLE and the business also has performed well enough up to 2020, he decided to sell his personal properties including house, lots, shares and vehicles so as to be able to raise funds.

22.0 With this, petitioner COLE was able to infuse another PHILIPPINE PESOS: SEVEN MILLION (Php7,000,000.00) in cash to DRCPI during the first quarter. DRCPI also again borrowed money from private individuals and small lending companies who still offered some short-term loans to support DRCPI's operations.

23.0 In addition, petitioner COLE re-structured his remaining personal loans from credit cards. This is for the loans he entered into and turned-over to DRCPI for additional funds. This move, however, eventually backfired. Because of the

restructuring, petitioner COLE eventually ended up with higher amount of debt. Obviously, the reason for the loan restructuring is because at that time- petitioner COLE thought that it was the best calculated-risk to take. Again, these were all done in the hope that the marke will recover and everything will return to normal.

24.0 With all these situation on-hand making orders for new containers, prioritizing the settling of the finance charges and initial interests on the loan restructuring agreements the company entered into DRCPI was not able to sustain the operations as it initially thought it could.

25.0 At present, petitioner COLE is now in a situation wherein he does not anymore have the capacity to pay all of his debtors banks, institutions, private individuals and credit cards. ORDER

Before the Court is the "Petition for Liquidation" filed by Petitioner Charmaine D. Cole (Cole, for brevity) praying that, after due notice and hearing, a Liquidation Order be issued and its consequent effects be enforced in accordance with the pertinent laws, rules and procedure governing Financial Liquidation and Suspension of Payments, Rules of Procedures for Insolvent Debtors.

Brief Background of the Petition

On 25 January 2024, this instant petition for liquidation pursuant to Republic Act No. 10142 and A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC was raffled to this Court. In the said petition, it was posited that petitioner Charmaine D. Cole is "experiencing financial incapacity to pay his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business and that his liabilities are greater than his assets."¹ Thus, the petition seeks for the Issuance of a Liquidation Order in accordance with Rule 4, paragraph (a), of the aforesaid A.M. No. 15-04-06-SC.² Petitioner Cole is a Filipino, married, and a resident of Block 81, Lot 20, Phase 4, Bel Air, Don Jose, City of Santa Rosa, Laguna. He is the President/Chief Executive Officer of Dynamic Resources Commercial Products, Inc. (DRCPI, for brevity).

DRCPI is a corporation duly formed, organized and existing under the laws of the Republic of the Philippines and its principal place of business is at Unit 25-27, Century Commercial Complex, Brgy. Salawag, Paliparan, Molino Road, Dasmariñas City, Province of Cavite, Philippines. DRCPI is engaged in the business of trading, marketing, distribution of, but not limited to, locally manufactured and imported machinery equipment, products and parts.

As admitted by the petitioner, he is the President/Chief Executive Officer of Dynamic Resources Commercial Products, Inc. (DRCPI, for brevity) and holds forty percent (40%) shares in the said company. Because of the economic set-backs caused by Covid-19, DRCPI's business operations started to decline which constrained the company to resort to massive borrowing of money in order to sustain its business operations. The said incident prompted herein petitioner to secure personal loans from banks, financial institutions and cash loans using petitioner's personal credit cards to sustain DRCPI's day-to-day operations.

"By the end of 2022, DRCPI had a negative deficit. However, it opted not to stop operations."³ In the year 2023, DRCPI considered applying for insolvency however, its Board of Directors, one of them is the petitioner himself, decided to continue its business operations. Thus, petitioner decided to sell his personal properties - including house, lots, shares and vehicles so as to be able to raise funds for the company. A copy of the Deed of Sale-Shares of Stocks dated 10 March 2023 of petitioner's 12,500 shares of stocks at CG Integra Corpora-

tion, Deed of Absolute Sale dated 25 December 2022 of petitioner's property located at Lot 20 Block 91 Phase 4 Laguna Bel Air, Brgy. Don Jose, Sta. Rosa City, Laguna and Deed of Sale-Shares of Stocks dated 04 April 2023 of petitioner from CG Integra Corporation was attached to the Compliance submitted before the Court in support of his claim that he sold personal properties for DRCPI. Accordingly, petitioner was able to Infuse another Seven Million Pesos (Php7,000,000.00) in cash for DRCPI. In addition, petitioner re-structured his remaining personal loans from credit cards and turned over the same to DRCPI for additional funds. However, because of the re-structuring, petitioner ended up with higher amount of debt. Accordingly, petitioner alleges that, at present, he is now in a situation wherein he does not anymore have the capacity to pay all his debtors.

In the Court's Order dated 30 January 2024, the Court dismissed the case for reasons cited thereat. Thus, on 29 February 2024, a motion for reconsideration was filed by the petitioner, through counsel. In the said motion, it stated that: "Verily, the insolvency in this case pertains to petitioner-movant COLE himself and not to a corporate/judicial entity."

In an Order dated 6 March 2024, the resolution of the motion was held in abeyance pending submission of additional documentary requirements needed by the Court to assess the propriety of the instant petition and the Court had set the case for clarificatory hearing. On 22 March 2024, an "Ex-Parte Motion for Extension of Time to Compliance" was filed by petitioner. Thereafter, on 08 April 2024, a "Second Ex-Parte Motion for Extension of Time to Submit Compliance" was then again filed by the petitioner.

On 11 April 2024, petitioner's "Compliance" was filed before the Court and petitioner stated the following:

1. DRCPI is no longer an on-going business corporation as it also filed its own Petition for Liquidation last 05 January 2024 before the Regional Trial Court of Dasmariñas, Cavite-Branch 128;
2. With the present depleted financial condition of DRCPI, petitioner could no longer ascertain the financial valuation of his 40% share in the said company for the purpose of determination of his assets;
3. Petitioner asserts that the debt incurred from his credit card creditors/bank creditors are in the nature of receivables and claims from DRCPI;
4. Petitioner also named three (3) nominees to the position of liquidator as required by law, namely: Van Conille A. Borromeo, Rolivic Malinao Perez and Leonora N. Barcelona;
5. Petitioner likewise stated that petitioner filed this case on his own, without including his wife, as his liabilities were solely incurred by him and that the same never rebounded to the benefit of his family; and
6. Petitioner submitted before the Court various documents to support his claim as required to him by the Court.

During the clarificatory hearing conducted on 18 April 2024, the Court took notice of the compliance submitted by the petitioner and the pending Incident is now deemed submitted for resolution.

On 08 May 2024, this Court issued an Order giving petitioner ten (10) days to show cause why this case should not be dismissed for failure to present clear and convincing evidence that the petition is sufficient in form and substance and that the prayed for order of liquidation shall not be in direct contravention of the order of the Special Commercial Court of Dasmariñas, Cavite pursuant to FRIA.

On 08 July 2024, this Court received the "Compliance (Re: Order dated 08 May 2024).

Thus, the instant resolution. According to the petitioner, under his present state, he is experiencing financial incapacity to pay his liabilities as they fall due in the ordinary course of business and that his

liabilities are greater than his assets.

As stated by the petitioner, the business operations of DRCPI went smoothly from the time it started its business in the year 2013 up to the last part of the year 2019. However, in the year 2020, when the coronavirus disease (COVID-19) became a global health issue, the business operations of DRCPI started to decline. Due to several economic lockdowns, DRCPI was constrained to resort to massive borrowing of money in order to sustain its business operation from various lending institutions, banks, including credit lines from petitioner Cole's personal credit cards. Petitioner likewise showed to the Court that at the order of liquidation shall not be in direct contravention of the order of the Special Commercial Court of Dasmariñas City, Cavite and there is a clear and convincing evidence that petitioner is suffering from insolvency.

WHEREFORE, after a careful evaluation of the evidence presented by the petitioner, the Court hereby finds the allegations in the verified petition to be sufficient in form and substance thus, the Court **GRANTS** the prayer for the issuance of Liquidation Order and accordingly orders the following:

1. Petitioner Cole is hereby declared insolvent;
2. The Court hereby declares the immediate liquidation of all the assets and liabilities of the petitioner;
3. The Court Sheriff is hereby directed to take possession and control of all the properties of the petitioner and safe keep the deed, vouchers, books or accounts, papers, notes, bills, bonds, and securities of the petitioner except those that may be adjudged to be exempt from execution, and to return to the Court an Inventory of the properties so taken within FIVE (5) Days from the time of the taking of such possession, If any;

All debtors and creditors are directed to file and submit to the Court the name of their respective nominees for the position of Liquidator at least THREE (3) DAYS prior to the date of the hearing for the election and appointment of such liquidator which is hereby set on **OCTOBER 22, 2024 at 1:30 o'clock in the afternoon.**
