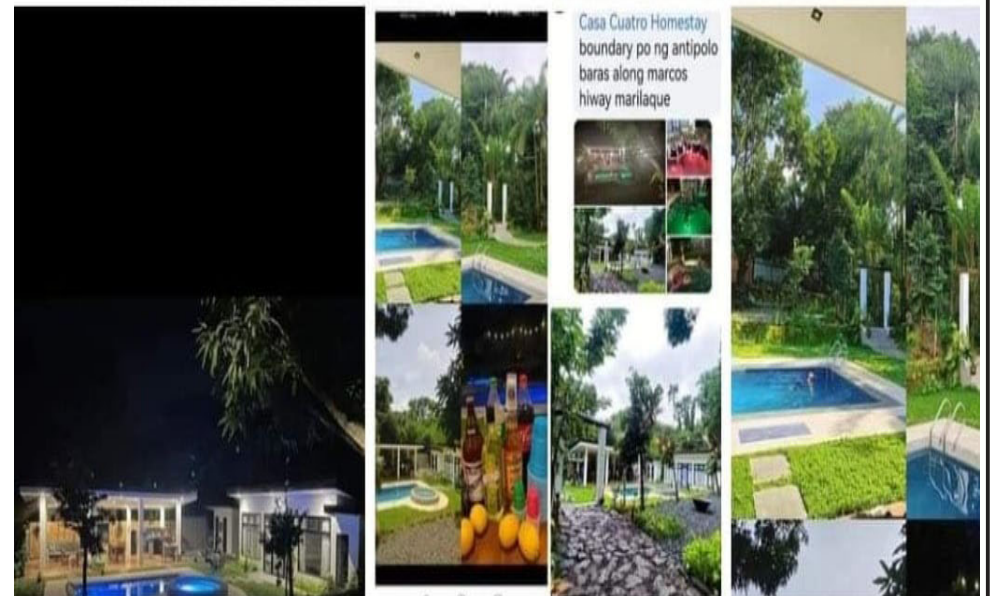
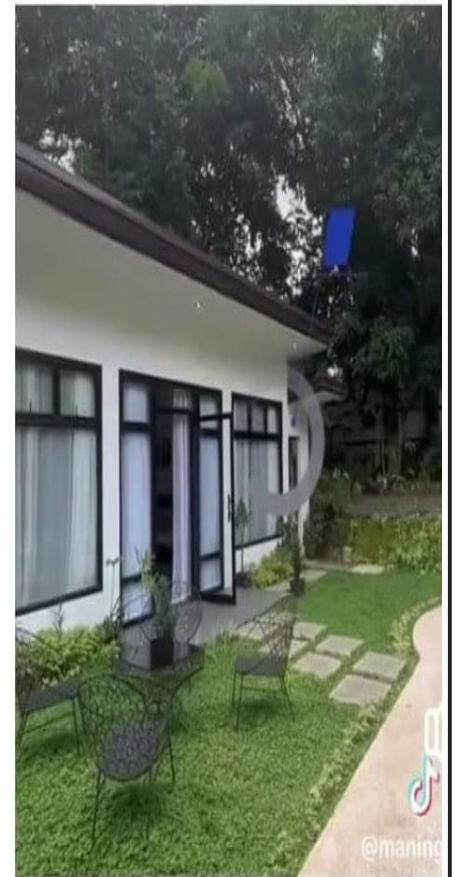

ORDER

For resolution is Complainants' appli-
cation for issuance of a Temporary Re-
straining Order.

On 18 January 2023, complainants
filed a Complaint with application for
issuance of Temporary Restraining Or-
der (TRO) and Writ of preliminary In-
junction pursuant to En Banc Resolu-
tion No. 8 Series of 2021, Rule 17 of the
Rules of Procedure of the Human Settle-
ments Adjudication Commission (HSAC).

A review of the allegations reveal that
the complaint failed to show that, if left
unrestrained, respondents' acts will
cause irreparable damage and injury
upon the complainant-applicant before
the matter can be heard on notice.

WHEREFORE, finding the
complainant's application for a TRO not
impressed with merit, the application for
Temporary Restraining Order is hereby
DENIED.

Also, respondents are hereby ordered
to file their comment/opposition to the
complainants' application for the issue-
ance of a Writ of Preliminary Injunction
within five (5) days from the receipt
hereof, copy furnished the complainants.

Moreover, respondents are hereby
SUMMONED and required to file a
written answer or counter-affidavit to
the complaint, together with all the
documents in support thereof, copy
hereto attached and served upon you,
with a non-extendible period of twenty
(20) days from receipt hereof, furnishing
complainant/s a copy thereof. No
motion to dismiss or motion for a bill of
particulars shall be allowed but any
ground proper for said motion, as well
as counterclaim, crossclaims, and third-
party complaint must be pleaded or in-
corporated in the answer, otherwise, it
shall be considered barred.

Respondents' failure to file an answer
within the prescribed period will cause
them to be declared in default and to
render a decision therein in accordance
with the facts alleged and proved by the
other party.

Furthermore, the complainant and re-
spondents are hereby notified that the
hearing for the application for the issue-
ance of a Writ of Preliminary Injunction
will be conducted on 05 December
2024 at 9:00 A.M. via Zoom Video
Conferencing.

Parties are hereby required to provide

pleadings. Subsequent notices shall be
