In the Order dated December 3, 2024, this Court granted that the Summons issue to be effected upon respondent Maria Teresa M. Dela Rama by publication in a newspaper of general circulation in the Philippines once a week for TWO (2) consecutive weeks, pursuant to Sec. 6(b) of the Rule on Declaration of Absolute Nullity of Marriage in relation Rule 14 of the Rules of Court, at the expense of the petitioner.

NOW THEREFORE, you are hereby required within THIRTY (30) DAYS after the last publication of this summons, to file with this Court and serve on the Petitioner your Answer to the Petition with the following principal grounds and reliefs prayed to wit:

"PSYCHOLOGICAL INCAPACITY FACTUAL NARRATIVES

7. When Respondent went back to Pagadian, Petitioner had to take an apprenticeship and went away from Zamboanga City for a few months. During this time, parties stopped communicating and Petitioner got somebody else pregnant.

8. After graduation, Petitioner was able to go abroad to work as a seaman. While abroad, he reconnected with Respondent who was also working as an overseas Filipino worker (OFW) in Hongkong.

9. In 2012, both parties went home to Zamboanga City and got married. Parties agreed that Respondent stop working as an OFW and Petitioner will be the one to provide for the family. Hence, Respondent stayed with Petitioner's family in Labuan while Petitioner worked abroad as a seaman. Hence, after getting married, parties lived separately most of the time. Petitioner was only able to go home to the Philippines once a year which lasted for three to four months.

10. Unfortunately, since both of them distrust each other, they had frequent arguments and disagreements and hope that respondent can cope up with her despite the financial support coming obligations as wife. Copy of the Affidavit from Petitioner, Respondent seemed to be uncomfortable at her in-laws' home. as Annex "E"

12. Things got worse when Respondent became the PTA President in her daughter's school in Labuan Central School where she got intimate with a teacher. It has been the talk in said school that she was having an affair with a married man to the detriment of her daughter's mental well-being, who was not spared of the rumors.

13. Sometime on September 2022, the rumors already reached Petitioner, who was abroad. However, he did not believe the rumors despite reading alleged conversations between Respondent and her paramour. But when it was his own daughter who would tell him of Respondent's secret rendezvous with a teacher he then decided that he has to go home. Machine copies of screenshots showing the conversation between Respondent and her paramour are hereto attached as Annexes "C" to "C-11" and void.

14. To protect their daughter, Petitioner tried not to confront Respondent with the issue until he gets home since she would lash out her anger towards their daughter again. In fact, Respondent threatened Petitioner that she would take her own life in front of their daughter.

15. On 5 November 2022, Petitioner went home to Zamboanga and confronted Respondent about her infidelity and even reported her to the police sometime on December 2022. Machine copy of the incident report is hereto attached as Annex "D"

16. At this time, it was apparent that Respondent is psychologically incapacitated to comply with the essential obligations of their marriage, though manifested only during their marriage life together. Which psychological incapacity of Respondent is incurable even after the lapse of many years therefrom since it is deeply rooted within the make-up of her personality. Respondent's psychological incapacity, however, was hidden and kept from the knowledge of herein Petitioner, until its manifestations were made evident during marriage.

17. Respondent's lack of understanding of the responsibilities in a marriage, her disregard of the sanctity of their marriage, her immaturity, infidelity, and misgivings, and, as a whole her lingering and unresolved psychological incapacity to perform the essential marital obligations indisputably caused her husband and daughter serious emotional anxiety and stress.

18. Petitioner, convinced of the futility of his efforts, decided that he deserves to start life anew with feelings of hope for a brighter future since there is obviously no arguments and disagreements and hope that respondent can cope up with her despite the financial support coming obligations as wife. Copy of the Affidavit of Petitioner is hereto attached as Annex "E"
