





ORDINANCE NO. 1241, Series of 2024 AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING THE STRICT MONITORING OF TELECOMMUNICATION CABLES AND TO UNDERTAKE IMMEDIATE REPAIR OF FIBER CUTS AND DAMAGED WIRES WITHIN THE TERRITORIAL JURISDICTION OF VALENZUELA CITY, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF, OTHERWISE KNOWN AS "BANTAY KABLE ORDINANCE OF VALENZUELA CITY"

Section 1. TITLE. - This Ordinance shall be known as the "BANTAY KABLE ORDINANCE OF VALENZUELA CITY".

Section 2. COVERAGE. - The provisions of this Ordinance shall apply to all public utility companies doing business within the territorial jurisdiction of Valenzuela City.

Section 3. DEFINITION OF TERMS.

- a. Fiber Cuts.
b. Public Utilities.
c. Telecommunications cable.

Section 4. STRICT MONITORING OF TELECOMMUNICATION CABLES. It shall be the responsibility of the public utility companies to strictly monitor their telecommunication cables to prevent the sagging, dangling and damage of its wires in order to ensure uninterrupted services and proper maintenance of the same to avoid hazard, danger, eyesore appearance and inconvenience to the general public.

Section 5. IMMEDIATE REPAIR OF FIBER CUTS AND DAMAGED WIRES. It shall be the responsibility of the public utility company to immediately repair fiber cuts and damaged wires and to conduct re-bundling, tensioning and fixing in order to arrange, elevate and straighten the wirings and cables which must commence within twelve (12) hours from the discovery or knowledge of the public utility company through its designated focal person.

Any subscriber or barangay official may report any damaged or fiber cuts to the public utility company focal person.

The barangay and public utility company may establish a barangay help desk for proper implementation of this ordinance.

Section 6. DESIGNATION OF FOCAL PERSON. The public utility company shall designate at least one (1) focal person to monitor its telecommunication cables in every barangay. Such focal person may be designated in a certain barangay and/or clustered barangay and he/she shall report at least twice a day, anytime in the morning and afternoon as to the status and condition of its telecommunication cables.

Section 7. LIABILITY IN CASE OF DAMAGE TO PROPERTY, INJURY OR DEATH. The public utility company shall be liable to any accident which may cause damage to property, injury or death to any person by reason of sagging, dangling, or cut wires/cables or violation of this ordinance.

Section 8. ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES. In case of violation, the Public Utility Company President, General Manager, Area Manager, Supervisor and/or personnel directly involved in installation and fixing of wires/cables or in violation of this ordinance shall be meted with the following administrative penalties:

The imposition, assessment and collection of administrative penalty is without prejudice to the filing of a criminal action against the offender/s if so warrants.

Section 9. PENAL CLAUSE. The Public Utility Company President, General Manager, Area Manager, Supervisor and/or personnel directly involved in installation and fixing of wires/cables or in violation of this ordinance shall be fined in the amount of Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00) or imprisonment for a period of six (6) months, or both subject to the discretion of the Court.

Section 10. IMPLEMENTING AUTHORITY; IMPLEMENTING RULES AND REGULATIONS. The City Engineering Office, City Business Inspection and Audit Team (CBAT), Liga ng mga Barangay, and Task Force Disiplina are hereby tasked to implement this Ordinance. Such offices through their authorized personnel are hereby given the authority to issue ordinance violation receipt in case of violation.

Section 1. Mandatory Singing of the Himig Valenzuela.- The singing of Himig Valenzuela shall be mandatory in all public or private Educational Institutions, official and formal events, functions and programs of national agencies and local government units within the jurisdiction of the City Government; and in the opening and closing of film showing in movie theaters in the City;

Section 2. Mandatory Playing of the Himig Valenzuela AVP and other AVPs of the City of Valenzuela. - The playing of the AVP of Himig Valenzuela and other official AVPs of the City Government such as but not limited to national anthem AVP and other future promotional or tourism promotion AVPs shall be played in all Educational Institutions; official and formal events, functions, and programs of national agencies and local government units, barangays, civic organizations events within the jurisdiction of the City Government; and on the opening and closing of films showing in movie theaters in the City, subject to availability of audio-video equipment;

Section 3. Voluntary Singing of the Himig Valenzuela and Playing of Official Valenzuela City AVPs. - The Singing of Himig Valenzuela and playing of Official AVPs of the City Government of Valenzuela is encouraged in programs, gatherings and events of people's organizations, non governmental organizations, socio-civic organizations;

Section 4. The Local School Board of Valenzuela is hereby authorized and directed to adopt forthwith measures to implement and carry out the provision of this Ordinance;

Section 5. The Cultural and Tourism Development Office and Public Information Office shall coordinate and inform concerned institutions.

ORDINANCE NO. 1243, Series of 2024 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING SECTION 30 OF ORDINANCE NO. 1028, SERIES OF 2024, ENTITLED, "AN ORDINANCE ENACTING THE VALENZUELA CITY LAND TRANSPORTATION CODE OF 2022."

SECTION 1. Section 30 of Ordinance No. 1028, Series of 2022, is hereby amended to read as follows:

"SECTION 30. MOTORIZED TRICYCLE OPERATORS PERMIT (MTOPTOP) – a document granting franchise or license to operate issued to a person, natural or juridical, allowing him/it to operate tricycle-for-hire over zones specified therein.

The tricycle franchise and MTOPTOP shall be valid for five (5) years. However, upon the expiration of tricycle franchise the MTOPTOP shall automatically deemed expired.

RENEWAL OF FRANCHISE AND MTOPTOP - Three (3) months before the expiration of the franchise, the appropriate application for its renewal shall be made upon the payment of particular fee.

For purposes of eventual synchronization, the MTOPTOP of all existing Tricycle Franchises prior to the enactment of this ordinance shall upon its renewal, shall be renewed only up to the extent of the remaining years of the present franchise. Thereafter, upon renewal of the existing tricycle franchise for the period of five (5) years, the corresponding 5-year MTOPTOP shall be issued thereof.

For purposes of computing the payment of MTOPTOP renewal fees, existing MTOPTOP renewal fees thereof shall be multiplied by five (5), corresponding the 5-year validity period.

The applicant shall submit the following documents for renewal: original and photocopy of the old certificate of Franchise and MTOPTOP, original and photocopy of current LTO registration papers, certificate of road worthiness, barangay clearance, current community tax certificate and recommendation for renewal to be signed by majority of the members of the Committee, if applicable.

No application for renewal shall be accepted if filed thirty (30) days after the expiration of the franchise, unless the corresponding fine of twenty five percent (25%) of franchise fee is paid."

Notwithstanding the issuance of 5-year MTOPTOP, the Tricycle Franchisee shall report annually to the Valenzuela City Transportation Office (VCTO) to claim the yearly regulation sticker and comply with other applicable requirements under the Land Transportation Code of 2022.

MOTORIZED TRICYCLE OPERATOR'S PERMIT (MTOPTOP)

Terms and Conditions

- 1. This MTOPTOP shall be valid for five (5) years.
2. The tricycle mentioned herein shall only ply within the zone assigned herein and are banned along national roads and highways.
3. The tricycle-for hire shall carry only five (5) passengers including the driver. (Ordinance #74 series of 2010)
4. Minors below thirteen (13) years old shall not be allowed to ride at the backseat.
5. This tricycle shall render service upon demand and shall not refuse to convey passengers within their designated zone of operation.
6. Minor drivers shall not be allowed to operate this motorized tricycle.
7. The operator shall employ only drivers with valid professional driver's license from the LTO with restriction code 1.
8. Applicant shall comply with other rules and regulations governing public utility tricycles: non compliance therewith shall be sufficient cause for the revocation or cancellation of this permit.
9. The tricycle shall be registered with the Land Transportation Office- Valenzuela. Failure to renew LTO registration for three (3) consecutive years may result in the suspension or revocation of the franchise. However, the franchise shall not be suspended or revoke if there is a valid and justifiable reason for non-renewal of LTO registration, such as but not limited to force majeure or humanitarian consideration while registration is being processed. Provided that, within three year period the tricycle has not been utilized for private and public transportation without a valid LTO Registration

CERTIFICATE OF FRANCHISE

Terms and Conditions

- 1. This Franchise shall be valid for five (5) years, subject to renewal three (3) months before the expiration date. Failure to renew the Franchise on time shall have a surcharge of twenty-five percent (25%) of the Franchise fee.
2. This Certificate of Franchise is not for sale. Any operator found to be using a Franchise not in his name will be automatically banned from securing a Franchise.
3. The Franchise is valid only for the tricycle mentioned herein. Change of motor will require another Franchise and the subsequent cancellation of this Franchise.
4. The tricycle mentioned herein shall only ply within the zone assigned herein and are banned along national roads and highways.
5. The tricycle shall not carry not more than five (5) passengers including driver. (Ordinance #74 series of 2010)
6. Minors below thirteen (13) years old shall not be allowed to ride at the backseat.
7. This tricycle shall render service upon demand and shall not refuse to convey passengers within their designated zone of operation.
8. Minor drivers shall not be allowed to operate this motorized tricycle.
9. The operator shall employ only drivers with valid professional driver 's license from the LTO.
10. This franchise may be revoked anytime by the Sanggunian, when any of the conditions herein provided or any existing law or city ordinance is violated.

ORDINANCE NO. 1246, Series of 2024 AN ORDINANCE ALLOWING ONE WAY TRAFFIC SCHEME AND ONE-SIDE PARKING IN ALL STREETS OF OLD PRODON, BARANGAY GENERAL TIBURCIO DE LEON, VALENZUELA CITY AND PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

Authored by : Coun. RICARDO RICARR C. ENRIQUEZ and Coun. MARIO B. SAN ANDRES SECTION 1. TITLE. This Ordinance shall be known and referred to as "ONE-SIDE PARKING IN OLD PRODON, GENERAL TIBURCIO DE LEON, VALENZUELA CITY".

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. X x x x x x x x.

- a) Illegal parking/illegally parked
b) One-side parking
c) Parking or parked
d) Traffic flow
e) Vehicles

SECTION 3. SCOPE AND COVERAGE. - The provisions of this Ordinance pertaining to the One-way Traffic Scheme shall apply to all motorists traversing through the area of Old Prodon, General Tiburcio De Leon, Valenzuela City, particularly in the areas identified under the One-side Parking Scheme Plan duly recommended by the Public Order and Safety Office. Moreover, the provisions allowing the One-Side Parking therein shall apply exclusively to the four-wheeled private vehicles.

This Ordinance, however, shall not be construed to confer any right of exclusive parking to areas adjacent to private property and shall not be construed to replace private parking garages or provide additional overnight parking to already existing access to private parking. Further, the implementation of this scheme shall be on a 24/7 basis except in the occurrence of disaster such as flooding, earthquake, fire and other emergency situations where the use of the road and parking is necessary.

SECTION 4. EXCEPTIONS. - This ordinance shall not apply to:

- a) Law enforcement vehicles, emergency vehicles, including ambulances, responding to law enforcement business, emergencies, or fire.
b) Official City/Barangay vehicles parked to conduct official business, including, but not limited to, delivery of public service, conducting road repair or engineering works and inspections.
c) Private vehicles when performing urgent tasks or when necessary for reasons of health, physical disability, or unique hardship only for the period necessary to accomplish their task or special purpose.
d) Temporary parking of moving vans, garbage pickup, and other service-related vehicles.
e) Individual private vehicles as duly approved by the Barangay for special events of limited duration.

SECTION 5. THE NEW TRAFFIC SCHEME. The new traffic scheme in Old Prodon General Tiburcio de Leon, Valenzuela City shall be as follows:

- a. Two-way traffic at the entry of Old Prodon to end except the portion of Yakal Street to Talisay Street;
b. One-way traffic at the entry of Yakal Street to the corner of Ipil Street and Talisay Street;
c. Two-way traffic the rest of Yakal Street;
d. One-way traffic at Ipil Street to Old Prodon Street, except a portion starting at the corner of Talisday Street;
e. Two-way traffic the rest of Ipil Street;

SECTION 6. ONE-SIDE PARKING. For purposes of this Ordinance, there shall be only nineteen (19) slots allotted for one-side parking in Old Prodon, General Tiburcio de Leon, particularly in the following streets:

- a) Left side of Old Prodon (4);
b) Left side of Yakal Street (10);
c) Left side of Ipil Street (3); and,
d) Right side of Talisay Street (2).

SECTION 7. ENFORCEMENT. - The responsibility of enforcement of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be with the Barangay Deputized Task Force in conjunction with the Public Order and Safety Office, Traffic Management Office (TMO), Task Force Disiplina, and Philippine National Police (PNP) - Valenzuela City. Provided this ordinance shall not be applicable until "No Parking On This Side" signs shall have been installed on the areas identified and designated as such under Section 5 and Section 6 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. LIABILITY. The driver of the involved vehicle shall be responsible and liable for payment of any fine, civil penalty, or such other fees arising from the enforcement of this Ordinance. Provided the registered owner of the involved vehicle shall not be responsible if such vehicle was in the care, custody, or control of some person who did not have authority or permission of the registered owner to use the vehicle.

SECTION 9. PAYMENT OF ADMINISTRATIVE PENALTIES. - Any violation of this Ordinance shall subject the offender driver/operator/owner to the following administrative penalties:

- a) First Offens - One Thousand Pesos (P1,000.00);
b) Second Offense - Three Thousand Pesos (P3,000.00);
c) Third Offens - Five Thousand Pesos (P5,000.00)

Payments of the said Administrative Penalty shall be made to the City Treasurer's Office upon presentation of the Parking Regulation Receipt accordingly issued to the owner/driver by the authorized or deputized City Government personnel or Barangay personnel. All collection generated from this ordinance shall be used for the maintenance of the City Government facilities.

ARTICLE I GENERAL PROVISIONS

SECTION 1. PURPOSE and COVERAGE – This Ordinance, which shall be known as the VC SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY ORDINANCE, is hereby promulgated for purposes of establishing and maintaining a database on all Sex Offenders convicted of Sexual Offenses against Children, residing, sojourning, studying, or employed in establishments within Valenzuela City, and further mandating Sex Offenders to declare the fact of conviction in their respective workplaces, and/or educational institutions.

SECTION 2. DEFINITION OF TERMS. a. Child or Children. b. Covered Industries. c. CSWDO d. CPC e. Educational Institution f. Sexual Offenses g. Sex Offender i. First Tier Sex Offender whose Sexual Offense is punishable by imprisonment of one (1) year or less; ii. Second Tier Sex Offender is any person: (1) whose Sexual Offense is punishable by imprisonment of more than one (1) year; or (2) has been convicted again by final judgment after being classified as a First Tier Sex Offender; iii. Third Tier Sex Offender is any person: (1) whose Sexual Offense is punishable by imprisonment; and (2) has been convicted again by final judgment after being classified as a Second Tier Sexual Offender.

Educational Institutions, Covered Industries, and Punong Barangays shall maintain a record of Sex Offender declarations and must ensure the confidentiality thereof in accordance with Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

The mandatory declaration of the fact of status as Sex Offender shall be made in writing in any form which shall include all the information stated in Section 3 hereof, and shall be duly received by the Educational Institution, Covered Industry, and the Punong Barangay.

Upon submission and receipt of the mandatory declaration, the Educational Institution, Covered Industry, and the Punong Barangay shall provide the Sex Offender a receiving copy, bearing the date and time of receipt, as proof of his/her compliance. Failure of Sex Offender to present his/her receiving copy shall be prima facie evidence of his/her failure to comply within this Section.

It shall, however, be unlawful for any Educational Institution or Covered Industries to refuse admission or employment, as the case may be, or to discriminate against the Sex Offender on the sole ground of his/her status as a Sex Offender, unless such Sex Offender is prohibited or disqualified by law or any lawful cause to enroll in the academic program or apply for professional employment, as the case may be.

SECTION 6. DURATION OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENT - A Sex Offenders shall keep the registration current and updated for a period of:

- a. Ten (10) years, if the Sex Offender is a First Tier Sex Offender;
b. Fifteen (15) years if the Sex Offender is Second Tier Sex Offender;
c. Twenty (20) years of the Sex Offender is a Third Tier Sex Offender.

Provided, that the periods hereinabove prescribed shall begin from each declaration or change in tier classification. Provided, further, that such periods shall exclude any time the Sex Offender is in custody or criminally committed in a custodial facility by virtue of an order or judgment issued by a court of competent jurisdiction.

SECTION 7. DUTY TO NOTIFY SEX OFFENDERS OF REGISTRATION REQUIREMENTS AND TO REGISTER - The appropriate authority shall shortly before release from custody of the Sex Offender, or, if the Sex Offender is not in custody, immediately after the sentencing of the Sex Offender, for the Sexual Offense giving rise to the duty to register -

- a. Inform the Sex Offender of the duty to register with the CSWDO an explain that duty in a language understandable to him/her; and
b. Require the Sex Offender to read a form, written in the language known to him/her, affixing his/her signature and/or thumb mark thereon, stating that the duty to register has been explained and that the Sex Offender understands the registration requirement.

Failure to notify the Sex Offender of the registration requirement under this Section shall not affect the applicability and enforceability of Sections 4, 5, and 8 of this Ordinance.

SECTION 8. MANDATE TO REGISTER AS A SEX OFFENDER. For judgment of convictions of Sexual Offenses occurring prior to the effectivity of this Ordinance, all Sex Offenders are hereby mandated to register with the CSWDO, in accordance with Section 4 hereof, within ninety (90) calendar days from the effectivity of this Ordinance.

ARTICLE III

ACCESS TO SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY

SECTION 9. AVAILABILITY and ACCESS TO THE SEX OFFENDER REGISTRY. Subject to the Data Privacy Policy and Manual of the City Government of Valenzuela, the CSWDO shall make available the Sex Offender Registry to Educational Institutions, Covered Industries, and Punong Barangays, whether in written or digital form, except for the Sex Offender's government-issued identification card, the identity of any victim, recent photograph and fingerprint, and such other

information classified as Sensitive Personal Information under Republic Act No. 10173, otherwise known as the Data Privacy Act of 2012.

ARTICLE IV PENALTIES
