2. Defendant VISUM VENTURES INC. (herein referred to as Defendant Corporation) is a corporation duly organized and existing in accordance with Philippine laws, with office address at Unit 205, O Square 1 Bldg., Ortigas, San Juan City, where it may be served with summons and other processes.

3. Plaintiff Corporation is engaged in the business of importation, manufacturing and supply of food packaging products, food service accessories and containers for various food and service establishments in the country.

4. From the May 2022 to July 2022, defendant corporation order from plaintiff corporation Paper Cups and Bowls and similar products worth Six Million Seven Hundred Fourteen Thousand Pesos (Php 6,714,000.00). This is evidenced and covered by some of the Purchase Orders issued by the defendant corporation to the plaintiff corporation, which is hereto attached as Annexes "C" to "C-4", respectively.

5. In compliance with the said Purchase Orders, the herein plaintiff corporation manufactured or produced the said items / goods worth Six Million Seven Hundred Fourteen Thousand Pesos (Php 6,714,000.00), in accordance with the

specification, design and trademark communicated by the defendant corporation.

6. However, out of the items or goods manufactured and produced by the plaintiff corporation and subject of the Purchase Orders, the goods or items worth Two Million One Hundred Seventy Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 2,179,530.00) remains to be unpaid.

7. Out of the Two Million One Hundred Seventy Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 2,179,530.00) which remains to be unpaid, plaintiff corporation was able to deliver to the defendant corporation items/goods/products worth One Million Six Hundred Eighty-Five Thousand Pesos (Php 1,685,000). This is shown by the herein Sales Invoices and Delivery Receipts, to wit:

6. With respect to the remaining goods/items produced by the plaintiff corporation, pursuant to the Purchase Orders, which is worth Four Hundred Ninety Four Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Pesos

(Php 494,530.00), the defendant corporation, without giving any reason, refuse to accept the delivery of the same despite the fact that these items were already prepared and manufactured by the plaintiff corporation, in accordance with the terms and specification of the defendant corporation.

7. The said items amounting to, or worth Four Hundred Ninety-Four Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 494,530.00), are still in the custody of the plaintiff corporation for safekeeping and thereby waiting for the directive from the defendant corporation for its delivery. This is shown by the Inventory Report which is hereto attached as Annex "BB".

8. Thus, as of April 2024, the unpaid balance of defendant corporation amounted to Two Million Seven Hundred Ninety-Seven Thousand Nine Hundred Five Pesos and Fifty-Six Cents (Php 2,797,905.56), inclusive of interest. As a proof thereof, Statement of Account of defendant corporation is hereto attached as Annex "CC", the statement of the total amount of Delivered Items as Annex "CC-1" and the total amount of Items refused by the defendant is attached as Annex "CC-2".

9. Demands were thereafter made by the plaintiff corporation against the defendant corporation for the payment of their outstanding obligation but to no avail.

10. Thus, on June 21, 2024, plaintiff corporation thru its counsel sent a Demand Letter to the defendant corporation in their given address at Unit PBCR-7 Connecticut Arcade, Greenhills Mall, Greenhills Drive, Ortigas, San Juan City. Copy of the said Demand Letter is hereto attached as Annex "DD" and LBC receipt is hereto attached as Annex "DD-1" and copy of LBC tracking who receive the demand letter and the date they received is hereto attached as Annex "DD-2".

11. Despite receipt of the demand letter, defendant corporation failed and continuously failed and refused to pay their due and demandable obligation to the plaintiff.

12. By reason of defendant's intolerable acts and practice employed against the person of the plaintiff, the defendant should be required to pay legal interest of twelve percent (12%) per annum from the unpaid obligation until the same is fully paid.

13. Due to the unjustified refusal of the defendant to pay the aforementioned obligation, the complainant was compelled to secure the services of a legal counsel and thus required to pay the attorney's fees in the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00) and appearance fee of Five Thousand Pesos (Php 5,000.00) per hearing, aside from filing fees and other legal expenses incidental to the filing of this case. Thus, the plaintiff must shell out no less than the amount of Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00), as legal expenses and cost of the suit.

14. By reason of the blatant violation and disregard to the plaintiff's right, the defendant shall likewise be ordered to pay the amount of One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00) as Exemplary Damages to serve as deterrent to the commission of acts similar to that of displayed by the defendant corporation.

15. In compliance with Rule 7 of the 2019 Rules of Procedure, as amended by A.M. No. 19-10-20 SC dated 15 October 2019, the following person/s/individual/s are to be presented as witnesses for this proceeding:

a) Mr. EUPHRAIM S. ORTEGA, to prove the material allegation in the complaint, including the value of the products manufactured and unpaid by the defendant corporation. He will identify and testify on the documents attached to the Complaint.

b) Mr. Dan Richmond C. Mahucut, one of the employees of the plaintiff corporation and he will corroborate the testimony of Mr. Ortega. He will testify on the fact that the items ordered by the defendant corporation were in fact duly delivered to and received by the latter.

16. The Plaintiff request to reserve one (1) more witness to testify on the statement of account of the defendant and the demand made

17. That the Plaintiff intends to present the following documentary evidence, to wit:

a) **Secretary Certificate** authorizing the representative EUPHRAIM S. ORTEGA to file the instant case, attached as Annex "A".

b) **General Information Sheet (GIS)** of the plaintiff corporation to prove the juridical personality of the plaintiff corporation and the position of the authorized representative Euphram S. Ortega, attached as Annex "B".

c) **Purchase Orders** issued by the defendant corporation to prove that the latter ordered the items/goods subject of this case from the plaintiff corporation, attached as Annex "C" to "C-4".

d) **Copies of Sales Invoice and Delivery Receipts from August 2022 to October 2023** to prove that the products subject of the Purchase Order was promptly delivered by the plaintiff corporation and were duly received by the defendant corporation, hereto attached as Annexes "D" to "AA-1".

e) **Inventory Report** to prove the fact that items ordered by the defendant corporation were already manufactured/produced by the plaintiff corporation as Annex "BB".

18. The Plaintiff corporation reserves the right to present additional witness and documentary evidence in the course of the trial.

PRAYERS

WHEREFORE, it is respectfully prayed upon this Honorable Court that after hearing, judgment be rendered to wit:

a. Ordering the defendant corporation to pay plaintiff the amount of Two Million One Hundred Seventy-Nine Thousand Five Hundred Thirty Pesos (Php 2,179,530.00), representing the principal amount of unpaid obligation.

b. Ordering the defendant to pay legal interest of twelve percent (12%) per annum from May 2022, the time when the obligation was incurred, until it is fully paid.

c. Ordering the defendant to pay exemplary damages in the amount of **One Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 100,000.00)**.

d. Ordering the defendant corporation to pay the plaintiff corporation the costs of this suit, legal expenses and Attorney's Fees in the amount of not less than **Two Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php 200,000.00)**.

Other reliefs just and equitable are also prayed for.
