**ORDER AND NOTICE OF
HEARING**

A verified petition was filed by Patrick Lawrence C. Choa, alleging, *inter alia* that on May 29, 2016, the petitioner was married to the private Respondent Kei Hashimoto, a Japanese Citizen, the marriage was solemnized in Soka-Shi, Saitama Ken, Japan; as of the filing of this petition, the parties do not have substantial property, real or personal, that would form part of the absolute community nor incurred any indebtedness of considerable amount thereto; the parties were not blessed with a child the petitioner and the private respondent were childhood schoolmates from Cabanatuan City, Nueva Ecija and were good friends back then, when Kei Hashimoto went back to Japan due to her citizenship, they did not lose contact because the petitioner often visited Japan, after several visits, they developed a liking for each other and eventually became sweethearts, after one year they decided to tie the knot on May 29, 2016 in Soka City, Saitama, Japan; their marriage was fine at first, but suddenly went sour due to the selfish ways of the private respondent; she was living as it she was still single and was always out drinking and partying; she would often splurge, shopping and dining everywhere using the hard-earned money of the petitioner; the credit that the private respondent was using, was being paid by the petitioner; the "devil-ey-care attitude of the private respondent resulted to a lot of fights with the petitioner; she promised to reform but she did not change, thus, the parties decided to end their marriage, on August 18, 2024, the parties were divorced, which was approved certified by the Mayor of the City Government of Soka City, Saitama Prefecture, Japan the divorced obtained by the parties is recognized by the laws of Japan, specifically the Civil Code of Japan under Section 4, Subsection I, Articles 703-709, the provisions substantially provide that the divorce may be effected by the husband and wife by agreement and shall have the same effect as it has been Judicially effected said divorce has been recorded in the Family Register of the respondent in Soka City, Saitama Prefecture, Japan, petitioner asserts that, the Philippine Law specifically the Family Code, recognizes the right of a Filipino citizen to remarry in case his/her foreign spouse validly obtained a divorce in the country where he/she is a national, this petitioner prays that divorce be recognized in the Philippines by annotating the same in the petitioner's marriage certificate.

WHEREFORE, let this case be set for hearing on **April 8, 2025 at 08:30 in the morning** at which date and time the respondent and other interest person may appear and showcase why the petition should not be granted and/or file his opposition thereto within fifteen (15) days from receipt of this order or from the last day of publication of this order.

Let a copy of this order be published once a week for three (3) consecutive weeks in a newspaper of general circulation at the expense of the petitioner and furnish together with a copy of the petition the Office of the Solicitor General the Office of the City Prosecutor, the Local Civil Registry of Quezon City, the Philippine Statistics Authority and Department of Foreign Affairs. **SO ORDERED.**

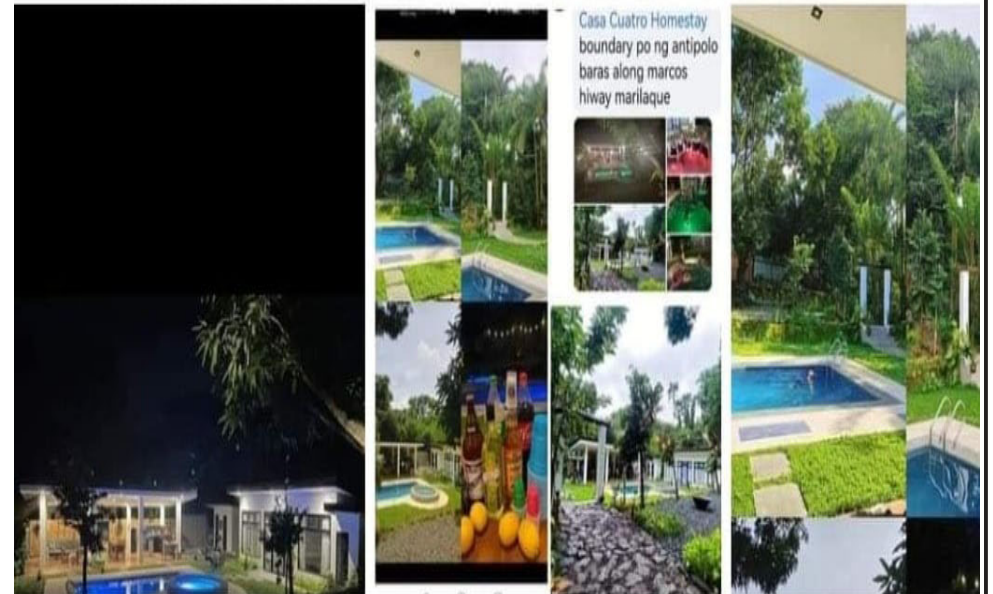
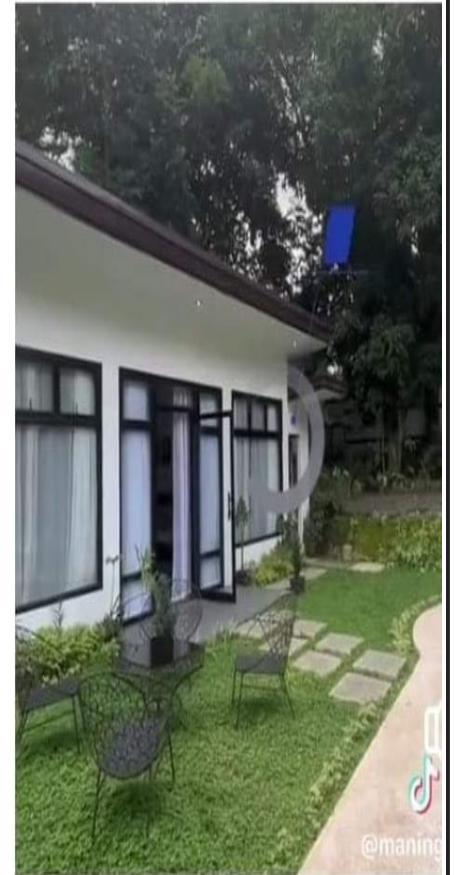
